Mission To Kenya, Africa

PM Crusade at Mukuyuni Village (Host Church Quakers-Friends Church)

Tony:

After a wonderful African style lunch served to us by the conference hosts, we headed off to the crusade site. After worship and fun with the children, we began to minister. There were maybe 50 adults and 200 children there. We gave words of knowledge and no one responded. Three of us had a word for right eye problem and we knew it was God. We waited a few minutes and everyone just stared at us. The team got into a prayer huddle and when we turned around there were 4 people standing there for prayer.

Tonight the numbers we prayed for were very small but we definitely saw God do some BIG things. The first man we prayed for said that he had an accident several years ago as a flying rock smashed into the top of his head and crushed his brain. His head was real caved in. It resulted in total paralysis and immobility on his right side. He couldn't move his leg or arm. As we prayed we asked him to lift his arm. He raised it right up, much to his amazement. He bent his knee and began to stomp his leg on the ground. He said that he felt intense electricity flowing thru his body. After giving testimony, he immediately walked away to show those that brought him there the wonderful thing God had done. He spent the rest of the night just standing right behind us just watching what was going on and smiling and laughing.

Another was a teenage girl that came hobbling. She said that she had broken her leg and needed to go to the hospital but her family had no money. She showed me her leg and it was bad, real obviously a bone broken. She was in bad pain. We prayed and God reset the bone and healed the wound. She was instantly pain free,

gave testimony and walked away totally normally, with not the slightest limp.

We were all involved in this awesome miracle with a little baby that was blind, but Vee will tell you.

The interpreter said she had already gone, but as I began to look around for her I stumbled upon a young girl carrying a baby boy on her back and noticed his eyes were severely crossed. I motioned for her to bring him forward for prayer and she immediately placed him in my arms. I brought him to the team. Tony asked for his parents, but they were not there, so we began to speak to the crossed eyes and we were joined by Caroline and Nancy in agreement. With each prayer we began to see progress, The interpreter started moving a finger in front of him and he appeared to be seeing it. I was excited and began doing the same.

Then Nancy gave me a shiny battery and he followed it back and forth repeatedly. That's when his mother showed up. Her face looked very puzzled. Upon questioning her, we discovered he was born this way (totally blind), but he had a twin sister who was completely normal. His mother said before he could only follow by hearing noises such as footsteps or snapping her fingers. She said he could not see at all. She started to cry when she realized he could see. We asked her to proclaim his healing and she placed her hand on his head and did so boldly and in length. Then the interpreter put a piece of gum in front of him and he reached for it, but the interpreter moved it and the boy followed it with his eyes until he landed the reach. He studied it for a few seconds and began undoing the wrapper as I held him and watched in amazement. I directed his hand to his mouth and he ate it. Then he was shown another piece and grabbed it quickly, unwrapped it with a bit more ease and then tossed the wrapper on the ground and ate it. He was given a third piece and with great ease grabbed it, unwrapped it, tossed the wrapper on the ground, and ate it. I was in awe to watch this healing progressing right before my eyes

The crusade got started a little latter than anticipated but the Lord still showed up. We had about two hundred plus children at the crusade. We had fun chasing them and giving them candy and stickers. I prayed for a lady with burning in her chest and severe back pain. She was healed. She winced as I touched her leg very lightly, but after prayer, she had no pain and went off smiling and not limping.

That's pretty much it, other than sharing in the joy of the mommy of a blind baby, who now has a child that can see! (at least 2 Kleenex) If that was the only miracle, it was worth the cold showers, the impassable rutted roads, and the hours of sleepless travel!!
