Mission To Kenya, Africa

PM Crusade at Nabingenge Village (host Endtime Harvest Church)

Tony:

Thank you for your prayers, we are extremely grateful!

It was a wonderful time of praise and worship at this location.

There was tremendous freedom in the Spirit! As the crusade was turned over to us I began with asking all the dancers to come forward. There had to be 30 of them, all ages. They have such rhythm and zeal that I just wanted an impartation. The team came up; they surrounded us and laid hands on us. It was really powerful. If you could imagine 60 hands flying, 30 bodies jumping and wildly singing and praying in Swahili as I hit the deck. They kept picking me up and down I would go again. It was absolutely great.

Now, I didn't know that this village was overwhelmed with drunkards. It was so cool to see that the message Holy Spirit gave me was clearly directed towards those with addictive afflictions and how liberating the gospel really is. We had a number of drunkards receive salvation.

We were surrounded tonight by all the people. We were in the center of a huge circle. There were lots of people looking for prayer tonight. The words of knowledge we gave out didn't seem to matter, everybody just pushed forward, no matter what the problem was.

We seem to be getting more of the "bigger" physical needs this trip. A lot of deafness, deaf/mutes, blindness, cripples. There are many testimonies that we cannot give from tonight because of a wonderful thing. There were probably 10 of the local believers and church leaders that were at the conference on prayer training that were also praying tonight. So, we had a team of about 20 tonight. This is awesome to see them really getting it and going for it and to

hear the hoots and hollers of the Kenyans seeing the miracles happening under their hands.

I have been really blessed to be praying with David, a man that is soon to become a pastor and begin a new church. He was powerfully touched and called by Holy Spirit when he was miraculously healed at the very first crusade we ever did in Kenya. A few of those I prayed for tonight are:

- A man that for 3-1/2 years had a back disability and his eyes could only see up very close. He could see nothing past a few feet away. His back was instantly healed as he demonstrated by doing deep knee bends that he couldn't do before. I told him to look up at the sky and he said, "I can see the moon very clearly, I can see, I can see, thank You Jesus!"
- A woman that has had malaria for 6 weeks. She said her head felt like it was coming off and all her joints were paining terribly. Since I know what this disease feels like, I could pray a very compassionate prayer. I felt the anointing flow thru me and she received like a sponge. She went flying backwards to the ground. We joined her down there until we knew the healing was complete. When she got to give testimony she shared how she felt a burning heat go thru all of her body and that all the symptoms were totally gone.
- A lady came with scoliosis. She was badly crippled and deformed. It was like her joints were all in the wrong places. She was on crutches and unable to walk. One leg was quite a bit longer than the other because her knee and hip were so displaced. She complained that most of the pain was all down her right side. This healing was in stages. As we prayed, the pain left the right side, but moved to the left side. We got the pain all out of her body, and then we concentrated on the bad joints. On the short leg side we saw and felt the hip and knee move back into place and begin to function normal. It is really wild seeing body parts move like this. Her leg evened out with the other. Then we took her crutches and said, ok, go

- ahead and walk. AND WALK SHE DID, right up to the microphone to give testimony. Lord, You are awesome!
- A teenage girl came and said that she had a hole in her heart and needed surgery that her family could not afford. I put my hand on top of her hand that she had on her heart. Her heart was beating so hard and fast it felt like it was gona come out of her chest. She said that it was always like that. As we prayed we felt it slow down and become totally normal. She was completely shocked at what God had just done for her. She excitedly gave testimony.
 - Another man with kidney problems and almost no hearing- totally healed and hearing restored.
 - So many other testimonies, but bye bye for now.

Vee:

A teen girl came to me with stomach pain she had for 3 ½ years. I got 2 of the pastors to agree and one of them placed their hand over her stomach and began to speak to the spirit. She was instantly knocked backwards a few feet and unconscious. I thought she had been touched and healed, but when she got up she said the pain was worse. I was with her when she awoke and Harvey joined me. We prayed and nothing, again, and nothing. We took her through deliverance for unforgiveness and she began to receive some healing and said she had less pain. Harvey and I continued to pray, but sensed she hadn't truly received salvation. So we led her through it and this did it. She received full healing. Hallelujah! We had many more healings here such as deaf ears, deliverance of alcohol addiction, salvations, and much more. We're all being blessed and our family is getting bigger! As for the elderly lady at the conference this morning, she brought her son here to join the crusade. She repeatedly thanked me before his arrival and as she saw him coming, she grabbed a hold of both my arms and would not let me pray for anyone until he arrived in front of me. She was even pushing the pastors away who were trying to get my help for others. When her son came, he spoke good English and so we

prayed. God healed him instantly and the mother was so grateful she found me even after the crusade to thank me again. I always repeated “Asante Yesu” –Thank you Jesus!!! Praise God for what he’s doing. It is so exciting. And the freedom today was astounding!

Another great meeting!! Worship was great and then P Tony had the worshipers pray for impartation to us of their rhythm. I got blasted and wound up on the ground for all of P Tony’s message. They set warm sodas before us and plates of cookies. This is always so humbling as we sit like a president and the small children stand back watching us eat. I got in late on the “dance” impartation, but then again I don’t need it as much in this area as Tony ☺. When I woke up this morning, I remembered a dream that I had. I saw a whole group of people lined up against a wall, and each one said that they had kidney problems. Guess what my first prayer request was? Yup, a girl with pain in both her kidneys. Healed! I prayed for a young girl who has been irritated by itchy skin rashes her entire life. Her dad is one of the pastors, and I had her mother lay hands on her and take authority. There were a bunch of drunks hanging around the fringes of the group, and as I headed to the land cruiser to get something, many

of them wanted to shake my hand (and breath on me). One asked if he could “borrow” my camera. Frederick came to rescue me and we prayed for the drunk instead. He accepted Jesus and said he didn’t want to drink anymore. He gave testimony to the entire village over the PA System.

I’ve been filming a lot lately something that I really enjoy. In a sense I get to see more than anybody else cause I am focusing on everything around me. I get to see all the testimonies. I’m really looking forward for what’s to come in the last few days.

We feel like royalty whenever we go to a new church in a new village. They are so giving, they would give you their last chicken and be glad to do it. They have no problem expressing how thankful they are that we have visited them. They’re exact expression is “we are honored to have the servants of the Lord.” This is very humbling to me.

The crusade began with the worship team leading in a very vigorous and long worship time. Tony served the team a drink of the spirit and that was it for half of us. We spend most of the worship time falling down. But it was good.

When Pastor Moto was called he asked some of the African dancers to come up to the front. He went on to say that we American’s just do not have the rhythm that they do and he asked the dancers if they would impart the dancing rhythm to us. Well that was fun. We had about 200 people rub our heads.

I prayed for a good amount of people and after a while they all seem to run together. We did have some salvations. I prayed for a pastor’s wife that had leprosy on her foot. As I began to pray for her she began to manifest. As I continued to pray she kept heaving

those fowl spirits out of her. We cleaned the house. I also had some healings for headaches and eye problems.

Fredrick:

Crusade at Nabingenge Market Center:

The response was very encouraging, I believe that it was because the crusade ground was near the conference was being held, and the word had gone around about what the Lord was doing, how people were being healed and delivered from demonic oppressions, people had traveled from far distances with their sick people to get healings. Indeed the Lord is always faithful to His Word many went back home glorifying God for His faithfulness.

The dominant spirits in the area are the spirits of drunkardness and witchcraft when Pastor Tony came on the stage to minister, he began message by giving his personal testimony about his past life when he was a D.D.O(Daily drinking Officer) and how God delivered him from the spirits of alcohol when he met Jesus, little did he know that he was addressing the problem that had affected the area that needed a divine intervention. Indeed he was led of the Holy Spirit to say those things, later on, many drunkards were prayed for those they came drunk and they went home sober and with Christ in their lives after confessing Him as their personal savior.

- A man aged about 75 years old came on the line to be prayed for, he had so many problems that he needed to be addressed by God through our prayers, ranging from his own health, his children and disputes with his neighbors over the land boundaries. I asked him if was born again, he answered me and said that is why am here am ready to receive Christ, I led him to the Lord Jesus thru confession. Then we prayed for the sickness, he was suffering from chest pains, backache, headache and bad sight he could not see properly things appeared to him as being covered by smoke. We laid our hands on him and he felt the power of God come over him

like a heat that shook him a bit, I asked him what was happening, he said I am much better and all pains are gone and I am free now.

- A pastors wife came on the line to be prayed for she had leprosy and also she was being tormented by demons at night, when she reach us she said in the local language please help me I am dying I have no peace, at that time I was helping Caroline for interpretations from Swahili language into English, I then asked Caroline to pray for her, immediately the hands were laid on her, she fell into a trance, she began shouting as demons were manifesting thru her, I also tried pray nothing was happening then I realized that she needed more counseling and personal deliverance on arranged time at a latter day, I called her husband and communicated the same to him and consented to it.
- A young man was brought to me totally drunk, when I asked him what he wanted, he told me that he was tired with being drunk daily, he was to be free and serve the Lord like some of his former friends who got saved and are now living a happy life in Christ. I hugged him on chest for a long time the I whispered into his ear and told him how Jesus loves and cares for him, he agreed then I led him into confession of Jesus Christ as his personal savior, when I released him from my chest I noticed that he was no longer as drunk and he came, and I had thought that I was going to smell alcohol because I had hugged, but I found out there was nothing at all instead I was drunk with power of the Holy Spirit, hallelujah!
