Mission To Kenya, Africa

PM Crusade at Bundambo Village (Host Church- Glory Church)

Tony:

After being served a wonderful African late lunch by our hosts we headed off to another small village in this district. The plan is to saturate the entire district with the kingdom of God. There were many, many children and they danced me into the ground. They are so much fun and such beautiful kids.

After encouraging them to come to Jesus, we gave out words of knowledge. About 20 people responded to all the words. I prayed for just 2. First was a lady that has been suffering for 3-1/2 years with uterus problems giving her constant pain. Also continual bad head pain and inability to function in life to do just the simplest tasks. She was hurting real bad. We prayed and the miraculous power of God came upon her and she felt the burning fire of His healing flowing thru her. She testified of total recovery and she jumped up and down and moved like she hadn't been able to in 3-1/2 years.

Second person was a lady that has been suffering with a debilitating rash on her body for 12 years. She said no one could help her and she just couldn't take it anymore. She was a Christian but had never heard that Jesus was her healer until now. She was ready and received instant healing as her skin cleared and all the pain left.
