When we were praying for the people I started with the small children. It always seems that they get over looked and are the last ones to be prayed for. Well, not today, they were first. The next man I prayed for was having trouble with his eyes and was also suffering with asthma. I prayed for his eyes first and he said all the blurriness and pain in his eyes was all gone. He is now seeing clearly so I moved on to his lungs. When I finished I told him to take a deep breath. He took a breath like he was not going to be able to get enough oxygen and when this huge breath of air rushed into his lungs he was in shock. I love the look of shock on their faces. He just kept taking deep breaths looking at me like as if he was saying "do you see this?" Needless to say this was one happy man. I then prayed for several women that all were suffering with chest pain and instantly all of them were healed too. It happens so fast and it is so simple that it's almost hard to believe unless you are seeing it with your own eyes, but even then it's like, wow! What a great morning.
