Sunday, October 20 2013 Mission to Sierra Leone Morning Church Services

Tony:

Thanks to all praying, I had a fantastic amount of God fun this morning! Off into the city to three different churches the team went. I was assigned to a small church that is only 3 months young. A very small mud building about the size of my bedroom at home, with 50 adults and 25 small children stuffed into that space. The 25 children were in a space about 6 feet x 6 feet. They sat thru the entire service joining in everything the adults were doing. I mean they were into it, what an amazing sight to see. The only instrument was drums and since there was so little space they all were dancing in a harmonic rhythm that looked like it had been choreographed. The pastor was just so excited, he said, I am going to look for a bigger place for next Sunday as we will have many more people, I need to make room for that right now. I had the pastor impart the anointing he had received at the conference, to all the people in the church, then I explained what they just got. My spirit was connected with these folks this morning. Somehow they were understanding what I was saying as I was saying it and they were hooting and hollering and shouting and waving their arms as I was preaching. I was absolutely sooooo much fun! Then I gave one word of knowledge and, get this, 20 people got out of their seats and jammed up in a huddle in front of me. I said, now, I want to show you the impartation of the Holy Ghost you just got from your pastor. I asked who had never seen a miracle thru their hands before. Well, that was about everybody. I said, watch this. I prayed for the first woman, healed in about 5 seconds. Then I had her pray for the next, healed in about 5 seconds. OH, the look of amazement on their faces! We kept doing that with each one healed doing the praying for the next one until all had received instant miracles. The pastor shouted, "people, take it to the streets, take it to your family and neighbors, take it to the sick Muslims, get them saved and bring them to church next week!"

Then I asked for anyone else that needed healing to stand. Well, that was everyone else. Get that, everyone had some kind of pain or sickness. All the people just healed did the rest of the praying and ALL were healed! I want to tell you, this little place was LIT UP! It had to be 110 degrees in this little building. It wasn't that hot on the streets, it was the Fire Of God in the place!

Then an older lady pushed thru to get in front of me, holding the hand of an even older lady. She said, "this is my neighbor, she is a Muslim and she is very sick, very weak and in much pain. I told her that if she would come with me today to church she would see what she has never seen before and get healed!" I said, OK, please just explain that it is Jesus that is about to do this. Then I had the church lady pray for her neighbor and then asked her to start moving around. It was amazing to see this old Muslim lady get touched by Jesus. I asked her, "has your religion ever done anything like this?" She said "No and I want this Jesus in my life NOW!"

Service ended, no one wanted to leave, they just wanted to hang out in the Glory in shock and awe of this clear demonstration of The Real Jesus!

Lisa:

We started off the morning and both Casey, myself and Tony split off to our own church to preach. I knew that I was suppose to give my testimony to those people because God had confirmed it through scripture the night prior. He had brought me to the same scripture earlier in Acts 18 that He had given me as confirmation before I went to Mozambique the first time last June. The scripture says, "When I returned to Jerusalem and was praying at the temple, I fell into a trance and saw the Lord speaking to me. 'Quick!' he said. 'Leave Jerusalem immediately, because the people here will not accept your testimony about me." Unfortunately, things did not work out exactly as planned that morning. Although I was able to speak, I was not able to give my full testimony because of time constraints. I felt confident though and spoke on deliverance and how important it is to do the things needed to walk out and maintain that deliverance. I gave bits and pieces of my story and still felt okay in what I said and exactly how it was said. I know it was the Holy Sprit speaking through me and not my words but His. I stressed the importance of leaving the worldly things behind, being obedient, staying in the Word of God and renewing your mind constantly. It's our faith and obedience that attracts God's grace. I asked the crowd how many of them owned a Bible. I was surprised at the response that was given as a small percentage of them raised their hands. It was later explained that this was a significant problem as some of the pastors do not even own a Bible. Emmanuel explained to us later the needs of the people and asked if we could get him thirty Bibles which would be of great help to those who are trying to disciple the people. There were five people that came up for salvation and then I asked for people who needed prayer to come forward. I prayed for each one of them and their pain left them. Oh, how GREAT is our God!
