Evening Crusade at Marriage Camp:

The crowd tonight had swelled to double that of last night. It is so amazing how the word spreads so quickly in these African cultures. The praise team asked me to dance with them because they said I can stir up the crowd. We had a blast and it is amazing under the anointing how there is not an ache in my body anywhere Plus now there are many that are doing the Tony chicken dance.

Casey stoked up the folks tonight and got them primed to receive the Lord. He is becoming quite natural at this, thank You Jesus!

During prayer, this night was very different than last night for me. I needed to pray for most everyone 2 and 3 times. Nearly all were receiving their healing but it was more work and persistence. It's definitely worth the persistence, but a slight change from the instantly. At one point the testimonies over the PA had slowed way down to no one (normally we will have anywhere from 5-20 people backed up to tell all what had just happened to them). That just meant the healings were coming slower. I felt we needed a salvation call now while faith is still high, thinking the evening was slipping. Well, Our God is a Big God and nothing slips thru His hands, especially souls. We gave the invitation and I was amazed, **again multitudes of people came running to give their lives to Jesus! I felt the ground shaking and there was dust everywhere from the people running at us.** It was so thick and so much dust that we couldn't breathe. They prayed to receive the Lord then were sent back to make room so we could pray. Throughout the night there was always a crowd just pressing in to watch the prayer to see up close what was happening. We had the pulling and tugging on us by people needing prayer again tonight, but not as intense as last night.

An 8 year old boy was pushed in to me by his mother. He had a hydroseal since birth. She wanted to show it to me, I told her not necessary as it was obvious just looking at him. The poor little guy was so uncomfortable. It made it literally impossible for him to play with other kids. This was the fastest miracle I saw tonight as I prayed once a few words and the boy smiled and said "mommy, it is gone!" She was in disbelief and put her hands in his pants and then started screaming for joy as it had disappeared!

A 1-1/2 year old baby had a big growth on his arm that just totally disappeared. Now that was cool, but let me tell you the one that really got me tonight:

When we gave words of knowledge a blind man was being led up for prayer. None of the words was for blind eyes. I looked at him and thought maybe someone else will get to pray for him. I have discovered that when I think that way I usually am the one to get to pray for them. Unlike last night, I wasn't moving in the gift of faith and I didn't feel I had it for this guy. That's really dumb thinking, by the way. He was an older man and his eyes were just white balls, no pupils. Well, sure enough, the mass of people surrounded us for prayer. I turned around to get a look at all those around me and bingo, there he was standing there. The people wanted me to pray for him first. Oh no, can't we make him last, I thought! Let me pray for some easy ones first. No, the people wouldn't have it. I prayed many times and he was still in total darkness. With all these other people needing prayer, I said to the lady that had

brought him, "please take him to one of the other pastors for prayer!" So they left. After about 15 minutes, bam, he's standing in front of me again. I asked him what happened, he said "Nothing, I want you to pray for me!" Now, everyone's watching me again to see what happens. Again, multiple tries and nothing, still total darkness. I sent him away again for someone else to pray. This happened two more times. Now on the fifth time of him coming back to me, I said to the lady that brought him "Are you a Christian?" She said yes. I said "You pray!" I put my arm around the man to hold him while I watched what she would do. I was thinking it might stop her from being so persistent with me, not actually thinking God would use her. She prayed a powerful prayer with the tangible sense of His Anointing on it. First prayer, the guy says "I see light!" Second prayer, he says "I see small, small!" Third prayer he says "I see figures!" Fourth prayer he says "I see people and colors!" The guy now has pupils and his eyes look normal. Wow, again I learn of the ways of the Lord.

This has been an awesome trip so far, thanks to all that are praying, the kingdom of God is greatly expanding these days.

Rev. Kettor:

This morning, today was a wonderful day for the work of Living for Jesus International. About 6 am in the morning people were running to the place where we are staying asking for prayer. They waited for us to pray and then all were healed. Many have gone out to tell others in the village of what Jesus has been doing. So, many have found out where we would be so they too could be touched by the Lord.

First we went to Gbah Town where we went house to house to pray for the sick. We experienced a lot of miracles and salvations and many went out to tell others. Then we went to Montgomery Camp. There we met a lot of sick people in their homes and we prayed for them. There was one lady that was house bound that could not walk. When we got to her and prayed she jumped up and started walking.

We prayed for the deaf and dumb today and their ears were opened and they were able to speak as all the neighbors gathered around to watch. As miracles were happening they would run to their neighbors and bring them back. We had crowds everywhere.

Because of the miracles that took place in Montgomery Camp the news spread around and excitement built for the evening crusade. We prayed for a sick man that was healed and then he took us to the area hospital where his daughter was being cared for. In the hospital we prayed for many sick people and watched them get restored. The doctor and nurses on duty stood and agreed with us for the power of God to come. Besides the sick people we prayed for the lady doctor asked us to pray for pain throughout her body that had been tormenting her for a long time. This doctor lady received a miracle and praised God!

As we were praying for the evening crusade, the music could not come on. The team on the site called and said we should cancel the crusade as they could not get the sound going. We prayed and agreed and God restored the system and the sound came back. All Glory to God!

At the crusade tonight, we experienced a lot of healing. Eyes opened, the deaf and dumb were hearing and speaking, back problems, every manner of sickness healed!

A man said that he could not see far, only about a foot in front of him, for all of his life. His sight was restored and when he gave testimony the crowd all knew him and rejoiced. The crowd was even much bigger tonight. When we gave the call for salvation, there were so many people that came that I couldn't see anything but people everywhere. It was so marvelous. It was an absolutely beautiful night full of rejoicing.

Pastor Instantly:

The healing miracles Jesus did this morning in the villages paved the way for tremendous anticipation tonight. Many were regretting that their family members that were sick were not there to receive healing. We received many invitations from people that traveled to the crusade tonight to visit their villages so their family could be healed. They were begging us to come.

I am today convinced that that the more we lay hands for healing the more that we get to see. It intensifies and expands greatly. If we could only do this every day this nation would be won quickly.

In the morning group of people that woke us up at 6am we saw all healed, 2 women that were totally, completely blind had their eyes totally, completely opened. Wow, were they happy to be able to see the world around them and to walk without someone holding their hands and leading them.

In this morning group we saw the following miracle healings: both total and partial blindness, joint, back, stomach, chest and intestine problems. Also there were deliverance issues settled.

Here is some of what we saw healed on the streets: Back problems, body pain removed, people unable to walk on their own were walking again, various forms of blindness all healed, men's private parts fixed, neck pain removed, young man stood for the first time in 4 years after an accident, a pregnant woman felt her baby leap in her womb as the power of God came upon her, all sorts of stomach problems healed, lots of headaches (some migraine for many, many years) all healed, lots of deliverance from all sorts of demonic activity.

Tonight at the crusade:

A man came to me and said "I want the white man to pray for me, but I cannot get to them, there are too many people, can you get me thru the crowd?" I told him "I can pray." And he said No! He had been nearly totally blind for the last 10 years. I said "let me try the black man's prayer to see if it is different from the white man's prayer!" and he consented to let me give it a try. I prayed and instantly his eyes opened up. He was amazed that God did that thru me. I said "hey, the black man's God is the same as the white man's God, what do you think of that!"

Here's a summary of some of what I know about: Lots of leg problems healed, one boy 14 years old was born with walking problems, now tonight is walking, chest and heart problems healed, lots of body pains healed, 3 deaf mutes ears opened and speaking (2 of them deaf since birth), all sorts of eye issues from

paining to itching to blindness all healed, lots of teeth, gum and jaw problems healed, many stomach issues healed, lots of back and vertebrae problems healed including one lady 29 years old with deformed back since birth that was miraculously straightened

Pastor Emmanuel Shonie:

I wanted to go out with the team today but have been suffering with back issues that make it hard for me to move. The team prayed and it instantly disappeared so I got to minister today and it was awesome. Saw so many miracles, one after another healed and saved. Thank You Jesus!

Casey:

Oh my days are running into the early morning hours and we just don't seem to have enough time for sleep on this trip. I'm not complaining one bit because this trip has been awesome from day one. We have been in so much of God's glory each day I would gladly trade a few hours of sleep for that.

Today was one of those days that no matter who we prayed for the healing just came instantly as we walked from house to house. The people in the villages were so friendly as they would invite us into their homes to pray for their sick family members. We ended up going to three different villages today and one hospital. At the hospital I even got to pray for the lady doctor that was having chest pain. The look on her face as Jesus healed her was priceless. Years of schooling to try and heal people and it only took Jesus a couple of minutes. The part of the hospital we were in looked like it might have been an outpatient room so they just let us walk right in and pray for whoever needed or wanted prayer. There were two sick babies and one sick woman in that room plus friends and family members as well. By the time we were finished here everyone in that room, sick or not, got prayer.

Earlier back in the villages we really had a blast just walking around looking for sick people, well we didn't have to look hard to tell you the truth. And once someone was healed it was like a care-a-van to the next house. A bunch of the children took us around to their homes and asking us to pray for their sick parents. You could spend days in each one of these villages very easily. One of the ladies that I had prayed for had some kind of an issue in her lower leg and foot. It was real hot to the touch and all swollen. She said it was so painful that she couldn't walk on that foot. I prayed the first time and the pain started to go away so I prayed again. This time she was able to stand and put pressure on the leg and foot. While she was standing I prayed a third time and I could feel the temperature on her leg drop and the swelling go down. I had her start walking and put her full weight on that foot. With each step she was getting stronger and stronger. When we were leaving that village we drove past her home and she was still walking and using her foot. Everyone was so shocked on how easy the healing came, no struggles.

I got to pray for another deaf mute girl in one of the villages as her mom watched on. The little girls ears open up right away and she started to speak for the first time. Her mom was in shock and looked like there was no way this just happened before her own eyes. I told her to talk to her daughter so she could hear her voice. With tears in her eyes her daughter heard her mom's voice and answered back the best she could. Needless to say they were excited today.

The crusade tonight was a bit of a battle we had to pray up to three times for some of the healings. I know you are probably thinking praying three times is not much of a battle and you are right. We have just gotten spoiled by Jesus with the "instantly" anointing. When you walk in that and get a taste of that there is nothing else that can compare, well so far. During the prayer time tonight I again got to pray for a young girl that was a deaf mute. I seem to be running a pattern here lol. I couldn't tell if she could hear me or just didn't understand me and the crowd was pressing again from all angles pulling at you and asking for prayer. So I just picked her up and held her in my arms all night. I even had her placing her hand on other people that needed healing as I prayed. I figured I would just let her soak in this healing atmosphere. At one point in the evening she had fallen asleep on my shoulder as my arm was going numb. Praise God she was a skinny little thing. When the crowd died down and you could hear yourself again I put her back on the ground and prayed for her again. This time when I finished she smiled real big at me and shook her head yes when I pointed at her ears to see if she could hear me. I knew her turn was coming and I was not going to give up on her. A few more prayers and this soft small whispering voice came out. It was so hard to hear but she was talking to me. To find out she was a real shy girl her mom said so I think she is just going to be soft spoken, but yet heard. Praise God for that. I also prayed for some blind eyes again tonight and tons of body aches and pains and everyone I prayed for received their healing tonight. Well it's morning again here 2:30 am and I have to get up soon to do this all over again so Later... Thank you again to everyone praying for us. Blessings
