Outreach to Montgomery Camp Village and other villages

We just arrived back at our home at nearly 11pm after an early start. As we arrived back, we watched one of the pastors go to the trunk and pull out a dead ground hog that was to be our dinner tonight. Oh boy!

After making it to sleep at 3am again last night, there were knocks on our door at 6am from many people that had come to receive healing prayer. It appears the word spread pretty quick of what Jesus was doing. When we got to pray for them, they were all sitting in the shade patiently waiting for us. They were mostly long term sickness that they have been living with for a real long time. They were all healed. One of the ladies had been suffering with arthritis for the last 15 years and was struggling just to get herself up out of the chair to stand for prayer. What an absolute joy to watch her move her fingers and the joints of her body without any pain. I have a feeling this was the first day she had really smiled in the last 15 years.

Then we spent the next several hours walking thru 3 different villages, house to house. This was quite an adventure. When the miracles started happening they would bring us to the houses of the very sick that couldn't come out. The people are so open and friendly that it is easy to start a conversation. Most sit outside their houses as it is cooler. They are all so gracious and thankful for our coming by their house and giving them such a gift of a touch from the Lord.

These were predominant Muslim villages we were in today and to my knowledge we didn't leave one house without ALL becoming Christians. Hallelujah!

Here are a couple of the testimonies:

A football player heard the people yelling about the healings and he came up to us with a wrapped up leg from damage he had received in a game. He was out and could not play from the pain and tear. We prayed, he felt the power of God flowing thru his leg, started jumping on the leg, no pain, so he took off the wrapping and started running, praising God! The people were so excited and he said, "I will be in the next game!"

We met an elderly man sitting in a chair outside his house. His family said he had a stroke and his left side was paralyzed and he couldn't lift his arm or use his leg to walk and was lacking feeling in that side. We prayed and he lifted his arm and put it on his head. He stood up and started walking, each step stronger. He walked a ways, turned around and came back all without any help. His family rejoiced.

We came upon a lady just lying alongside her house wheezing with asthma. She said for 15 years she had been unable to breathe well or to smell anything. She was very weak, and it looked like this disease had just taken its toll on her. We prayed and she started taking deep breaths and rose up healed! The neighbors watching were just amazed at what Jesus had done.
