FOURTH NEW CHURCH BEGINS IN MUSLIM VILLAGE

We were told that this village was totally Muslim. It has been declared by the village chief that the town is Muslim and there is no need for Christianity to be there. Many times ministers have tried to reach this village with the good news of the Gospel. They have been rejected EVERY TIME. To have such a program as we had this evening is evidence of a God invasion. For many years this has been a problem for the Gospel not to reach to these people. But, tonight, The Lord has done a great thing for the people. For the Gospel of Christ, of His Kingdom has entered. Many of the residents have given their lives to Jesus. The people that were at the meeting tonight have declared to start a fellowship. Even the Chief that has been stopping other Christian ministries from bringing Christianity to his village, was willing for us to have our Gospel service. This is an unprecedented decision in this place. Breakthrough came for the people in this village.

Bad down pouring rain attempted to stop us from going this evening. In most African nations, when it rains, they stay inside their homes. Another vehicle breakdown kept us from getting there early. So, when we arrived late, we went to the Chief to find out if we still had an opening. He said, "It is late and raining very hard and many of the people are sleeping. I do not think any will come, but go ahead and start singing and if any come then you can continue!" Well, continue we did. About 60 men, women and children came out. We don't know how many stayed at home, but Our God was about to start a new Church with these 60 people.

We gave 2 words of knowledge and nobody acknowledged. I knew that they were real, but the people had never seen this before. (By the way these people later came for prayer and received their miracles). A few of the younger people started mocking. I asked Holy Spirit to please give me words that He knew they would respond to right now. "We need a demonstration, Holy Spirit!" So, next He showed me a lady that was nearly blind in one eye. It was pretty hard to hide it or

be shy when I called her out. I'm sure she thought "how did he know that!" She came up and at the same time another lady came up with a similar problem of near blindness in one eye. They were still both Muslims (as we hadn't invited anyone to receive Jesus yet) and God completely opened their eyes while they were yet lost! Then another young man walked up and said, "I have very bad heart problems and much chest pain, can Jesus heal me?" We prayed and instantly he was healed. We gave the microphone to all three of these people and they told their fellow villagers of what Jesus had just done for them. All of the people got a real sobering look on their faces. They all applauded. Amazing how a miracle in your face can stop your mocking. OK, it was now time to lead them into salvation! Again, EVERY ONE of these 60 people received the Lord tonight.

There was a consensus of the people at the end of prayer, that they would like to start having meetings immediately. We ended the night with some of the pastors and the new pastor meeting in huddles with adults, young adults and teenagers discussing the start of the new church.

The people have said that they have never seen anything like this in their lives before and are anxious to begin to worship God together.
