

Mission to Sierra Leone Pujehun Village

Sunday Services and Candle Light Procession 5/16/2010

Tony:

The team that went to Moyamba, Sierra Leone, in February of 2008, will remember the candlelight procession thru the town. The whole Body of Christ is planning that for this evening here. This place is still about 99% Muslim, but that has begun to be changed and will be radically changed by the end of this week. Please read Emmanuel's explanation of what we were doing in the prayer walk below. I had a very real sense that HISTORY was being made tonight as the Body of Christ prayed. I felt the atmosphere shifting at each prayer point. The whole prayer walk was about 6 hours long and covered about 10 miles. There was a truck with big speakers, a generator on it with pastors taking turns as Holy Spirit led leading us in specific warfare prayer and worship along the way. It was amazing how much specific knowledge of demonic entry points, wisdom and discerning of spirits was coming. I felt like a spiritual pigmy as I saw the grasp that the church here had on spiritual warfare. The progression of this last week's events are now clearly seen by me as necessary for the great move of the Spirit that will come this week as we get out to the villages for crusades.

During the prayer walk and young man ran up to me, knelt down beside me and grabbed my hand and put it on his head. I asked for interpretation of what he wanted. He wanted to be delivered from addictions and alcohol. I stopped to help him get free and he later got off the ground rejoicing that he had been liberated.

I have been told that I am the first white person that the younger generations here have ever seen. They are Muslim, for now, but have been showing me love. The children are all so beautiful, impoverished, but happy. Early this morning they told me that I was going to be taken to the radio station and that I would be preaching on the radio. They gave us 20 minutes, so with an interpreter off we went. Thank you Lord for bringing that Word to many.

This morning all the pastors and LFJ team went off to preach the "Kingdom of God" in a lot of different places. Some have returned to report that the Presence

of The Lord was extremely strong and miracles were done in Jesus Name. They were all so excited!

They put me in the largest church (maybe 150) today. I began with demonstration by giving words of knowledge and had the people pray. It was so cool as there were a lot of people there that had not seen this type of ministry before. They were all expecting that I would be doing the praying. They were shocked to see the miracles thru the people's hands and roared with praise at every miracle. Had a couple of ladies with arthritis in their wrists get a miracle. Then a young child about 7 years old had damaged his wrist somehow. He was very shy until his wrist got reset and the pain left. Hallelujah! Then a bunch of people came with bad joints, and paining joints. A drunk man came up and I asked him if he wanted to pray for a lady that had joint problems. When I asked him to ask her if he could put his hand on her, she said "NO!" She said "that guy is not going to touch me!" There was another man next to her that had come for prayer and he wanted to pray. She said OK to this guy. Everyone got healed and the people were just amazed at all that happened thru their hands. Now we turned to the drunk guy last and asked what his problem was. He said "my teeth are paining me!" I said "that is not one of the words of knowledge", then he started like a cartoon character by opening and closing his jaw again and again, then he said, "it is my jaw joint!" Everyone was laughing. My interpreter prayed for him and in a few seconds his teeth were completely fixed and interestingly, he seemed to Sober Up! Wow!

Emmanuel:

I have to give information about the match today (between the kingdom of light and the kingdom of darkness). The theme for this match is called 'Breaking Fallow Ground'. Most of the places where we stood to pray along the prayer walk route are places that have been demonically manipulated over the years. At the first place we started is the entrance to the city entrance. That has been a place where human sacrifice has been done, and anyone who comes to Pujehuh, has to pass through that place. Whatever determination you have for the progress of the district will be buried there. This means you will not continue with your plan of

developing the Pujehun town. This town has never been able to develop. There are no utilities of any kind, no means of communications of any kind, it is definitely fourth world and very, very depressed. Many young children, like virgins, have been killed and buried there. Some of the children were even buried alive. This was done by demons, thru people, under the guise of political power, to have command over other people so that whatever they say will be final.

The second place we went was the bridge. It is the place of where cannibalism has occurred. Parts of the woman were cut off and the blood was drunk by the demon possessed people.

The last part where we ended: An old man told us today of the history of the round about area where we went to lay our hands on the ground to take it back for Jesus. A long time ago they took the Bible and put the Koran on top of the Bible and buried them, so the Koran would be primary over the Bible in this district. Also, recently there is a tree that was cut down and they found a county pot (3 legged pot) that is used to hold blood for sacrifices. The commissioner found out that there were demonic meetings at the tree and he had it cut down. When they cut it down, they found the pot (still full of human blood). We prayed for the uprooting of all those demonic altars that has been laid by the ancestors of these people.

This is the **FIRST TIME** in history that such prayer has been done for Pujehun. There were more than 300 persons in white t shirts and candles in the prayer walk as we went thru the streets. To bring back the glory of God to this place!
