

Mission to Liberia, Africa 2009

Pastor's Conference Day 2, Friday, November 6, 2009 Location: Brewersville

Tony:

At the end of the deliverance training session we had the people pray for each other in order to be liberated. The sound was like thunder as they all prayed at once. I could feel a lifting in the atmosphere. A very clear shift had occurred over this place. I stood before them when they finished and it was as if I stood in a cloud, wow, what a powerful release had occurred. We just lifted up our hands and asked for more of His wonderful Presence. I asked for those that felt they were being powerfully touched to come forward. A number of people came up and they were just vibrating with His Glory. A pastor lady that stood before me felt a great cleansing and liberating going on in her, that she was being sovereignly delivered.

Many of the people I prayed for the rest of the day said that they felt something leaving them and felt very "free". We had lots of pastors alongside us participating in the praying. There was a little usher lady that brought a woman to me and I asked the usher lady if she would pray. Her eyes got real big, I helped her a little, and she moved into miracle flow. She was amazed at what she was seeing. Every manner of cure was being released thru her hands. When she laid her hands on the first (nearly) blind lady and prayed, then when she asked what was happening, the lady said "my eyes are completely clear, I see perfectly!" This little usher lady said, "Are you sure?" She was so amazed at such a glorious and powerful release of the healing of God thru her hands.

A man that just pointed to his throat and made a little groaning sound. I didn't understand what he was saying; I figured it was a sore throat or something. We prayed, he started smiling and then went to the microphone for testimony. As it turns out, the man's throat was constricted for years and he was unable to talk and barely able to breathe, or eat, FOR YEARS. In a moment, he gave testimony of how it completely opened up and God restored him.

How about the man that had his left side completely immobilized from a stroke. He said that it felt like he was dragging a tree stump around as he tried to walk under the power of his right side only. He was touched and his left side responded as his arm shot into the air and he was lifting his left leg and taking steps. Glory to God!

One of the pastors brought his mother today, that was crippled. She was sitting in a chair as we prayed. We asked her to get up and start walking and she did! At first with a little assistance, then after a few moments, all by herself, under God's Power. Thank you Jesus!

Many people healed of years of tormenting pains in an instant.

Another nearly blind lady said that as we laid our hands on her eyes she saw a river beginning to flow and then water was pouring on her head, then we took our hands away and her eyes were totally restored, wow, Lord!

At one point Harvey and I looked at each other and said, "Do you see what's happening? The more miracle testimonies that are given, the bigger the group of people is getting around us for prayer!" Then someone grabbed the microphone and yelled out THE LORD IS HERE TO HEAL, come and be healed. Then it looked like we would be here until tomorrow, except for the anointing! Yea God!

How about this: A pastor lady that was almost deaf went thru deliverance and the moment she cast out the deaf spirit and asked Holy Spirit to come and fill her, that moment, her ears totally opened! She was so excited sharing her testimony!

Day two was a total blow out, enough said...

Ok I know that's not fair to all of you so I will give you my take on what I saw today, or let's just say I'll try. Tony taught two sessions today and the first session was on deliverance. I love to watch the crowd and the expressions on their faces when this is taught. Their eyes get sooooo big until the revelation hits them of who they are in Jesus. Then it's just pure excitement. I thought at one point they were going to lose it as they were jumping up and down and shouting for Jesus.

Who would have thought this kind of response from deliverance training? Most people want nothing to do with it, but not here. Harvey and I gave them a demonstration on what deliverance looks like, they loved that. When the teaching was finished Tony had them find a partner and take themselves through deliverance. You could feel the atmosphere change when they were finished, WOW! When they were finished we started to pray for anyone that needed prayer. I know it's only the second day here but already I'm having a hard time remembering everyone I prayed for. There are just so many. Oh, wait till we get to the crusade. All I know is the blind are seeing, the deaf are hearing and the crippled are walking. The Holy Spirit is really moving and the healings are coming quickly. I got to pray for this young woman that was blind in her right eye. You could see like a white spot over her pupil and she said everything was all dark. After I prayed I removed my hand and right away she began to look around to check it out. She started to get excited because she was now seeing light. I placed my hand back over her eye and prayed again. Now she was seeing shapes and color, yeah God. After the third shot of prayer she was seeing totally out of that eye. I don't understand everything I always see because there was still that white spot in the center of her eye, but she could see perfect and gave God all the glory. This ministry remains a mystery to me, but there's no backing down, full speed ahead! I also prayed for a woman that chopped her hand with a machete years ago and her hand wasn't working. That only took one prayer and her hand was totally healed. She was bending it up and down and opening and closing her hand just looking at me with this look on her face like, what just happened! I told her that's Jesus not me He healed you.

The second session was on words of knowledge and that teaching is always a success and they seem to catch on quick. Again after the teaching we invited anyone up for prayer again. Now the Pastors are getting into the action so I didn't get to pray for as much this time. There was this one older woman that they carried up from the back of the room and sat her in a chair behind us. It was like she was invisible to everyone else or they didn't want to pray for a crippled woman. When Tony and I finished praying for the person in front of us we turned and bent down and asked what she needed prayer for. Like we didn't know, huh?

She said she has been crippled for months now and she can't stand or walk. So we each took a leg and started to pray for her. As we were praying she was just looking around at everyone walking by not even paying attention to us praying for her. Well we finished praying and said to her stand and walk. To make a long story short she did. It took a few laps across the front but not long after that she was walking all on her own with a huge smile on her face. God is good. There are so many more people I prayed for and that God healed, WOW, there really aren't any words to express this. So on that note, Blessings to everyone covering us with your prayers.

Today was another awesome day on the mission field. The hunger and excitement with those attending the conference continues to grow at an ever increasing pace. Brian:

This was the second day of the pastor's conference and Pastor Tony taught on deliverance. At the end people were invited up front to pray for each other, but the people just kept coming, so the team jumped in. A lot of pains in shoulders, stomachs, arms and legs left pretty much instantly. Every manner of sickness and disease was being healed. Oh God, what I saw next was awesome!

I went on to this young girl, maybe thirteen or fourteen, and she said she had been in constant pain ever since birth throughout her body and even pained her terribly to walk, which was evident the way she moved her legs. All she could do is move very slow when she walked, and she said she had never been able to run because of the terrible pain she was in. I invited the Holy Spirit to come which is something I almost always do before going after the healing. The Glory must have really gotten turned up, because from the way the girl was moving it was evident that the Spirit was moving all thru her. After a few minutes I commanded all the pain to go and the girl opened her eyes and moved her legs up and down and said all the pain was gone and she was completely healed. This was a big miracle, praise the Lord.

The next person in front of me was a young woman, maybe in her thirties, and she said she had extremely poor vision. I had no idea as to the extent of her problem or how long this had been going on, so I just dove in again and the Spirit was all over the woman too. After a few minutes she said she could see better, but still not one hundred per cent. After more soaking I commanded all the blindness to go and she said she could now see perfectly. Another big miracle, but I had no idea how big until a few minutes later. It is such a blast to watch the Lord work when the Glory comes down. I wish it was like that all the time, but it isn't. Pastor Kettor our host, the one who had invited us to Liberia had been having people give testimonies over the microphone. When the woman got the microphone she said she had been into the bush, which means way out in the middle of nowhere. Some stuff somehow fell into her eyes going in deep into her eyes and she had been almost totally blind for fifteen years. For fifteen years she

had spent all of her money on doctors and hospitals and she said that no one could help her, not even in the slightest way. She heard about the conference and had traveled a great distance to get here. She said that the Lord healed her in an instant. You could feel the level of faith going thru the roof in the place.

The next person I ministered to was a young girl about twelve years of age, and her mother said she had a demon who threw her on the ground. I asked her when that happened last and she said three or four months ago. I kept talking to her and her mother for ten or fifteen minutes asking questions trying figure out what type of demon this was and how it got into the girl. It seemed like I was not getting anywhere and was becoming concerned that I probably could not help this girl. I had forgotten that this is all about Jesus and His desire to restore is far greater than my inabilities and weaknesses. Then she said one of her problems was she felt dizzy all of the time, so I ministered to her for that and she said that all dizziness had all left her. I took her up front to give a testimony over the microphone. Pastor Kettor interviewed her and figured out, because he can understand the local dialect, even though it's supposed to be English, that the girl had had epilepsy. But they call it something else here and it had caused her to be constantly dizzy. She was crying as she testified about her healing, it was a very emotional to hear her.
