

Mission to Liberia, Africa Foya Village

Conference Day 2 AM

Tony:

Special thanks to all that are praying for us. We pray you would be greatly blessed! I am looking forward to reading the report written in heaven from what God did this morning. Wow, wow, wow!

We limited attendance this morning to only pastors and church leaders so that we could teach and impart without the masses. We got in our huddle on the stage as the time of worship was ending and His Presence became overwhelmingly evident. As we were praying we felt an atmospheric shift and change to the aroma of heaven. Spontaneous prayer erupted all over the building. Oh, what a beautiful sound as voices were lifted up. It was a heavenly harmony. It was heavens preparation for invasion. It was a forceable eviction of any evil presence. We were now ready to see a clear demonstration of the ruling power of the Lordship of Jesus.

They really seemed to receive the teaching on deliverance with enthusiasm. And after a time of praying for each other in deliverance we felt impressed to invite them to come for prayer again. We again requested all the pastors to join us. What happened next was nothing short of an explosion. I could feel the anointing come as the measure of His Glorious Presence increased. The miracles began happening quickly. **After the first few blind eyes opened up and deaf mutes received their hearing; people were running out and grabbing their sick relatives. But when a lady that had been crippled most of her life and unable to walk GOT UP and started walking, the place erupted!** We thought we were done a few times and the people just kept coming. It was no longer just pastors, but the village people were coming in. There was a particular moment that the anointing lifted and the miracles stopped. It was at that point that we ended the service as there was only about an hour before the next service!

My favorite for this session was: TWO young men who were deaf mutes all of their lives. Their mother's were standing there watching with looks on their faces like "OH God, will you do this for my son!" As their ears opened and they responded to my voice and attempted to repeat the Name of Jesus their mothers wept. The boys just couldn't stop trying to speak with their new ability to hear what they were saying. They were sooooo happy! Just bouncing with excitement!

Evening Service:

We drove up to the Meeting site and there were a few thousand people around the outside of the building. We couldn't go in the front door because the people were too jammed in there. We had to go in a side door as they moved about 50 people out to make a path for us to go in. It was about 200 degrees in the building, at least 100 of those degrees from body heat. There was absolutely no room to pray for anyone. We were wondering what Holy Spirit would do tonight. We announced that we would start the crusade tomorrow night instead of Thursday night due to no space and the intense hunger of the people. Casey roughly estimated that there was about 2400 people INSIDE the building. After just a short message about how much Jesus longs for them to come to Him, we gave a word concerning those who had spent all their money on witch doctors trying to get well, but were not only physically worse, but now had no money. We had a few people come up and one man called up to the platform. He was a child of God, but the church had not been able to get him healed or to help him. So, he turned to the powers of darkness for help. He was almost totally blind and totally deaf. As all the people watched, we prayed and Holy Spirit came upon him in a moment gave him PERFECT vision and PERFECT hearing! He rejoiced and told everyone there what Jesus, the TRUE GOD had done for him. We then gave those in the building an opportunity to receive Jesus. I think about **200 PEOPLE RECEIVED SALVATION!** From there it was impossible to pray for anyone else, we couldn't get to them, so we closed the service down until tomorrow night where we will be outside with lots of room.

BOBBY

OK. So I figured it out. Giving a word of knowledge in Liberia is like going into a MacDonalds with 1000 people in it and saying "There's someone here with lovehandles and a craving for French fries." You end up with most of the people responding no matter what the word of knowledge is. They are just so hungry for a touch from God. We kind of shut it down early and we're going to start the crusade a day early tomorrow so we can take it outside where there is room for all the people. It is just too many people for too little space inside.

We had a lot of salvations and a man who was blind and deaf get totally healed. That was awesome! As we were getting ready to drive back to the house the deaf mute who got healed in the morning session came up and just started chattering up a storm and boy was he happy!! He still couldn't be understood but he even tried to sing and he was just absolutely elated. I love it when God heals someone and they are just so incredibly grateful. His smiling face was worth the trip right there. Got to get his picture tomorrow. More later, time to get a bucket shower and go to sleep.

Casey

Day two is in the record books and yes it was another home run derby. The Holy Spirit was knocking them out of the park today. The session was on deliverance I know everyone's favorite, but it really needs to be taught and understood if you want to minister in love. The building was once again packed out standing room only, but this time it was only pastors and church leaders. No riots this morning to report. The teaching went real well and the pastors and leaders really got it. Bobby and I got to teach them as well by doing a mock deliverance so they could see how easy deliverance can be. I must say Bobby is a much better actor than I and he had the all laughing as he tried to manifest. This proved to be easier said than done when the translator seems to be translating with the amplified version. Way to hang in there Bobby good job. When the session was over we started to pray for anyone that needed prayer with the help of the local pastors so they could get into the action. The jumped in with both feet and seemed to be having fun. Debbie and I were praying with two other pastors off and on. We saw blind eyes open and all kinds of sicknesses being healed. I can't even count how many got healed, just the hours and they never stopped coming. It was one after another until the anointing lifted. Debbie has a great story about a blind man we prayed for that I will let her tell you that one. I will tell you that the blind man is now seeing only in one eye at the moment but I know he will see in both eyes by the end of the week.

Evening service/riot: yes once again the natives were restless and all control was being lost. We got to the meeting kinda late so worship was already going on. We had to use the side door to get into the building because there were soooooo many people packed in the building that there was NO WAY possible to get through the front door. It felt like we were rock stars being brought in through the side door up by the stage, but of course I know Jesus is the star and we are just his roadies. I am ok with that really. I don't have much to report about the service because it was very short for us. We didn't stay very long maybe just over an hour or so. Tony gave a short message and a salvation call, 200 plus saved tonight. As far as praying for the sick that turned into a whole other thing. The crowd was pressing in so hard Rev. Kettor called the meeting and told them to come back tomorrow night for the open air crusade where we would have more room. I think it was wisdom plus this lets everyone get caught up on their reports well if I could type faster LOL. Blessings to everyone still praying for us Thank You!

Evening meeting

Boy, Nothing like making History! I have to keep reminding myself this isn't a dream, this is all really happening! My faith level is increasing more and more every meeting. Tonight we

arrived at the meeting late. Our morning session went longer than we thought. God started flowing and I don't know about everyone else but I lost track of time! The team went down to pray for them, Arlene and I prayed with a mother and her two year old baby who is a deaf mute. I can't even tell you how cute this little baby was! 95% of the time (from what I've experienced here so far) the babies are afraid of us whities when we get too close, they cry or burry their faces to hide. But this little girl, we laid our hands on her and she smiled real big and just stared at us. Every time I smiled she would, so we exchanged a bunch of smiles while we were praying. Haha. We didn't have the chance to see her get healed tonight, because the crowd was released and literally crushed us against the stage. There were people tugging on me begging me to have Jesus heal them. There was this one man pulling himself along the ground under the crowd. He grabbed at my ankle as I was getting back up on the stage to get ready to leave. It's almost heart breaking. It was decided to bring the meeting to a close for the night and ask everyone to come back tomorrow night, because it was just too much to try to handle in the building. We will be outside tomorrow with much more room. We asked the mother of the deaf mute baby to bring her back tomorrow too, so we can sit and pray with her, and hear her talk for the first time . 😊

Well now, this is more like it! We started off the morning session with prayer and it was nothing but us and the pastors in the building. It was still packed but just not like the overflow we had yesterday. The prayer was extremely powerful! All the pastors were praying out loud and it was like a holy roar going up to the heavens. We were in a circle with our arms around each other and we were getting zapped big time! It was truly an anointing that came down that was off the charts. When we got into prayer it was totally different than yesterday as far as the ease of seeing what sometimes are more stubborn infirmities being healed. We were seeing blind eyes opened, deaf mutes get healed, the lame were walking, it was just one right after the other. The pastors were doing the praying and we were just guiding them and the looks on their faces were priceless! The one I was working with had two back to back. The first one was a girl who was totally blind in one eye get her sight restored and then a young

man who had been a deaf mute since birth had his ears open up and was trying to speak but couldn't for the sounds correctly. Once we realized this was normal for someone who had never heard speech before or had to form words with his mouth we just told his family to work with him like they would work with a child learning to speak. He did manage to say 'amen' when the pastor told him to say amen. God is just awesome! It's great to see the pastors getting excited about taking this new knowledge and putting it to practical use. When they understand the power they have in Christ and start to exercise authority, the demons are in big trouble.

Keep up the prayers. It's so important to have the covering from all the prayer warriors putting the devil to flight. You are tearing down strongholds.

! This morning's service was crazy! Not like all the meetings aren't... haha I only wish I could remember every single healing, deliverance and salvation that took place. God is so good! Anyway, here's one of the healings I saw God do this morning .It was a boy probably about 12-14 years old. He came up limping and asked for prayer for his left leg.

He said it was in pain and he was obviously having a hard time walking straight. I was partnered with Arlene, and another Pastor from a local church that was interpreting for us. When we laid hands on his leg you could tell his leg was crooked and much skinnier than the other. There was pretty much no muscle in it. We prayed twice and he said the pain was only "getting smaller". So we asked him what happened to cause his leg to be the way it is, and he said that he was tormented by a dragon. He said it comes at different times and scares him. He also said someone wished this cripple spirit on him. So after he said that we realized it deliverance and breaking curses that were spoken over him. So we had him go through deliverance, taking back any ground that might have been given to the enemy and binding the spirits and casting them out. After all that we prayed again for the healing, having him agreeing with us to command life into his leg. After we prayed he said the pain left and he was jumping and stomping his on the ground! Yay! 😊

These pastor's are going to take so much back home with them and make such a difference in their own communities and are going to now be able to truly help change peoples lives. Even the pastors are hungry to know God more...know what his will is....to know Him more intimately so that they can pray the father's heart and do it knowing the authority they have! I continued pulling pastors out of their seats to pray with people and kept checking in with the three other pastors I had set up praying for people. As the pastors finish praying for the healing and some I were working on deliverance with a few questions here and there but all seeing so many healing, Holy Spirit kicks it up a notch, and in from the street come more people. I look across the room and see Rev. Ketter holding a cane, with another pastor standing next to him as they watch a lame woman start walking. Well that just started a stampede for the front, hehe. But this stampede was headed up on the side of the room I was on with a group a people wearing shirts that said Disabilities do not mean inabilities. I checked on the woman pastor and she was just finishing hearing a woman tell her that her blind eyes are open, and her arthritic hands had just straightened out. I smiled at her and said well let's kick it up a notch and I turned a young man with an arm that was totally in a z formation from the wrists to the shoulder. She stayed with this man and saw a good measure of healing and we told him to keep

coming. This pastor (sorry I don't remember her name right now) GOT IT, and Got IT solidly. She was stoked!!!! As the miracles continued This is what is so important about Living for Jesus's ministry – "THEY GET IT", the People and leaders get it so they can move in His truth, and kingdom reality. SO COOL!!
