GLORY EXPLOSION CONFERENCE– SIGNS, WONDERS, AND MIRACLES

Randy's Overview of the Entire Conference:

FRIDAY EVENING:

This mission trip to Greenwich, New York provided us the beauty of a New England fall weekend, and the sweet presence of our Lord. The facilities of the Christ the King Spiritual Life Center are located on six hundred acres of some of the most beautifully forested hills of upstate New York. The Glory Explosion was definitely a God inspired event that brought Christians together from many denominations.

Our team of four from Florida was greeted warmly by our host, Frank and Claire Vurraro and by the prayer ministry team members of Christ the King. The meeting tonight started with a very anointed worship team, and Casey and Marie got lost in worship with their flags. I served as the video camera man, a position that Harvey normally holds. I had a few get acquainted problems to work out with the camera but then things went smoothly.

The chapel was packed and even had people overflowing into the reception area. We were blessed to hear father Nigel, an Episcopal priest, speak on hindrances to receiving healing. He gave some vivid stories from the time he served as a British Commando in Northern Ireland, and his testimony of coming to a place of forgiveness touched every heart in the room. Afterward during ministry time our team members paired with those of the center and prayed with many seeking healing.

Although I didn't pray with people tonight, I saw through the lens of the camera a room full of people in one accord in their worship of God, and their sincere seeking of His healing touch. Our team was added to by a dear friend of ours from Massachusetts, Robin, who is a leader among the Catholic Charismatic movement of Cape Cod and the south shore of Massachusetts. Our whole team bonded with her instantly.

I am quite sure our Heavenly Father was very pleased by seeing His children come together in unity and love for one another. A big thank you goes out to all who are praying for us and for the success of these meetings.

SATURDAY MORNING:

The morning meeting was again almost filled to capacity with people hungry for more of God. We were again blessed with wonderful worship

provided by the worship team of a local spirit filled Methodist Church. It was a different flavor than last night's worship, but every bit as effective at bringing all of us into the Glorious presence of a loving God.

Pastor Tony ministered this morning and I can tell you he struck a chord with all who were present. The people received his ministry very warmly indeed. Some of his stories about food on his mission trips may have temporarily discouraged some from going overseas, but I think their hunger to go will win out in the end. They really responded to his statement that "ALL" can pray for the sick.

There were words of knowledge given and then the many prayer teams scattered around the room to provide ministry stations for the people to come to. The ministry time was lengthy as many sought the powerful touch of Jesus upon their lives. Frank announced that the kitchen staff was kind enough to extend the lunch time for us, so the ministry time didn't need to be rushed.

I was so impressed with the effort of everyone at the Center being focused on making every guest welcomed and helped in any way possible. Wonderful things can happen when God's children will come together in love.

I am realizing that the camera man is in a unique position to view the meeting as a whole. It was a wonderful sight to behold. Thanks again for your kind prayers.

SATURDAY NIGHT:

Tonight was very festive as we were blessed by a worship team from a Messianic Jewish congregation. Along with very talented musicians we were treated to an extensive group of worship dancers. The worship had everyone in movement, and the sound of the shofars touched people's hearts. It felt like we were worshiping in Jerusalem.

The speaker tonight was Rabbi Steve, and he gave a wonderful and very picturesque look from the scriptures concerning what the Glory of God is. I am so glad we have it on video. I know it will eventually bless many beyond this meeting.

The ministry time was again very lengthy but very wonderful to see. People were getting healed all over the room. That is the benefit of having such a large and well trained ministry team. It was a pleasure for our team members to pray alongside our brothers and sisters from New York.

The worship team played a very Hebrew sounding song at the end of the meeting and people were dancing all over the place. The joy of the Lord filled the room, and his Glory rested on His people.

After the meeting was closed, our team was asked to do an impartation for the many ministry team members. We all gathered in the back chapel and our team went around to each of about fifteen prayer team members. Since I was serving as the video man during these meetings, this was my first chance to lay my hands on people and pray for them.

The Lord was gracious to me in giving me visions for everyone I prayed for. Jesus then gave me prophetic words which explained the visions for the people. They seemed really blessed, and I was also. A deaconess, whom I know at the Christ the King Spiritual Life Center, told me that the words spoken over her by our team members went far beyond anything she had ever heard before in their accuracy and their effect on her.

I know that the fruit that was produced at the Glory Explosion will remain, and even produce continued fruits in everyone's life that were present. Thank you all for your love and your heartfelt prayers on our behalf.

Tony:

We thank The Lord for the privilege to be one of the ministries asked to participate in this conference. This was a multidenominational gathering and an answer to prayer. We not only got to minister, but also to be ministered unto powerfully. We thank The Lord for our gracious hosts, Frank and Claire. Servants truly after the heart of God!

Here is a sampling of what I personally saw God do in front of me:

- During the session that we were given to lead: The people were eager to hear about what has been made available to them, on a practical basis. We gave words of knowledge and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of the people present came forward. We knew that it was time for a demonstration of the power of God. As the people were jammed all around us up front. We began by praying for a lady that had been in an accident and was living in constant torment. Her joints were arthritic and doing anything was very difficult. **Everyone watched as Holy Spirit moved from one part of her body to the other, releasing healing anointing. She took steps without pain for the first time in a long time. She said "I am totally restored!"** We asked for a couple of people that had never seen a healing miracle happen thru their hands to come up. They excitedly watched as the power of God flowed thru them.
- I saw a couple of people that were nearly deaf have their ears opened. There was one sweet 90 year old lady that said she had been coming to the healing meetings at the center, but had been

unable to hear what was being said. The lady that brought her said "she can't hear!" I shared testimony with her of how we had seen many deaf mutes miraculously healed, in one meeting. Her face lit up and I felt a strong faith upon her. **I laid my hands on her and very quickly she said, "Oh, I can hear much better!"** We tested it out as I stood about 20 feet away from her and spoke in a quiet voice and she said "I can hear you perfectly!" Hallelujah! Glory to God!

- One of the words was for chest pressure and heart palpitations. One of the men stood waiting for prayer and God spoke to him and said, "as soon as he prays for that other person, you receive the prayer and you will be healed." After I prayed for the first lady, he raised his hand, and I actually thought that he had another word of knowledge to share. **He told everyone that he was instantly healed the moment we prayed for the lady. He said "years of having this problem had ended, I am healed!"**
- A lady that had arm parts removed and replace with artificial was in serious pain. After prayer, movement was restored and all pain gone! A creative miracle? Hallelujah!
- A young man carrying lots of demons and knowing that he was strongly under their influence came for help. He admitted to multiple conversations with them as they kept him in constant confusion. He could not explain how it all started so Holy Spirit revealed the source. He reaffirmed Jesus as Savior and Lord and we led him thru deliverance until he was free.
- I could hear numerous sounds of praise and excitement, coming from other prayer teams, as captives were being set free and damaged bodies restored. What a wonderful sound it was!
- A man in ministry for a number of years had been in an accident many years ago and received prayer numerous times, without any change. He had become resigned to accepting his infirmed body and had totally stopped praying or seeking prayer for healing. Holy Spirit spoke to him about his unbelief and hurt. We agreed as he took himself thru deliverance and took back all the ground given to the enemy. **When we prayed again, the power of God came upon him mightily and set him free every which way. He moved body parts that had become inactive due to constant pain.** Wow, what a privilege to be there when Our Daddy makes someone's body "just as it is in heaven!"
- Another lady unable to receive healing from much prayer over the years. Holy Spirit revealed a spirit of bitterness blocking the

healing. The thought of finally being free brought a quick agreement in deliverance prayer and BAM, the power of God came upon her. Liberty, liberty, liberty. That would be pain free liberty, in the Name of Jesus, came to her house. Bless God!

- It seems as if arthritis was taking a pretty good hit as joints were being miraculously restored.
- We ended the sessions, Saturday evening, with our team having a time of impartation to the "Christ the Healer Center's Prayer Ministry Team". **This is always one of my favorite parts of our ministry, as we give away** the anointing that has been given to us and as we prophetically speak into their lives. I truly felt the love of Jesus for each one of His children that we imparted to. Wow, such hearts for the Lord! We look forward to receiving back testimonies of "transformation"!
- Our time in Greenwich was ended in the living room of Frank and Claire as a prayer shawl was placed first over me and then over Casey. A wonderful young woman of God, Robin, prophetically prayed over each of us and brought great confirmation to our callings.

Marie:

There is nothing quite as beautiful as the foothills of the Adirondacks in October. Although not at their "peak" color, the trees offered us more than a splendid show of brilliant red, yellow, and orange leaves. Those leafy branches were back dropped by puffy white clouds and crisp blue skies which left us with fresh awe for our Creator.

As if that display – sign and wonder – of His love was not enough, we entered into a realm of the *holy* during the "conference" that left us and many others humbly grateful simply to be called children of God!

The weekend event was truly an ecumenical event as speakers, prayer team members, and attendees came from a wide variety of Christian streams. **Methodists, Episcopalians, Catholics, Baptists, Pentecostals, Messianic Jews, nuns, priests, and others all gathered IN ONE ACCORD!** This was a display of unity that was far more colorful and glorious than the fall foliage painting the hills which surrounded the Christ the King Chapel.

The worship that flowed from three different worship teams opened the atmosphere for the Presence of the King to come. People were free to dance, to wave flags, to raise their hands, or to simply sit in adoration. Earlier in the week, one person had a vision of the Lion of the tribe of Judah sitting on the hill opposite the entrance of the chapel. I am certain

that He felt welcomed as the guest of honor as His touch was surely upon the people in marvelous ways.

More happened in the three meetings than what we can possibly recount. Testimonies will be ongoing for many days to come. And, we hope to share more with you at a later date. For now, please enjoy some of the ways the Father expressed His love to people I was able to pray for at the meetings.

First of all I will share two testimonies written by an old and dear friend from Massachusetts, Robin Rumbolt, who was able to join the Living for Jesus International team for the weekend and help us in our praying for the sick. She also became one who greatly refreshed Tony, Casey, and our hosts, Frank & Claire Vurraro, through her wonderful prophetic anointing.

"I want to share a part of my testimony for the weekend. **I came in on Friday in pain.** My neck, shoulder, back, wrists and hands were aching. By the time I got there it was a chore holding the steering wheel. Needless to say, when I started flying (flags), as Casey calls it, it was very difficult. I knew I had to press in.

There was such a burning need in me to worship that I decided I would do it unless someone told me not to. I have had pain in my left shoulder blade off and on for 13 years. The last couple of years it had become difficult to do anything that required strength with my left arm. When the Lord told me on Saturday that He wanted me flying with both arms I made a decision to do it whether or not it caused pain. I asked the Lord for strength and to have shoulder blades called out if He wanted to heal it. Since I only had 1 flag with me I had to borrow the others. I'm very grateful for Casey's willingness to share. The anointing on his flags is as nothing else I have ever encountered.

When worship started and there was no place to fly I became confused. I knew that the Lord told me to do it. So, I took it out into the lobby. I did that for a while but there were still obstacles. Then I spotted the room on the other side. I went in and let myself get lost in worship.

When they called out healing of shoulder blades I ran as fast as I could to the sanctuary. I knew that was for me. I can't actually say when the healing came because whenever I come under the anointing of God I feel no pain so it could have happened in the worship. In any event, it is gone. **I drove home stopping only once and arrived home without hand, wrist, or shoulder pain. Praise God!**

My husband, Steve, has a **protruding disk** in his back and has been in pain for weeks. While I was on the floor I remembered that when a man takes on a wife the two become one so I received healing for his back

also. I asked him how he felt when I got home and he said "good". I believe God healed him without him knowing it. Time will tell. I pray that the harvest from the event will be bountiful.

I have another testimony. God is just so awesome. I couldn't sleep last night so I grabbed my iPod and did some soaking. I noticed when I put the ear pieces in that it seemed louder than usual. I didn't really think much about it until about 20 songs later when I realized that I was hearing it the same in both ears. I've had partial hearing loss in my right ear for years. I'm assuming this happened Saturday morning. I got in line to get prayer when they were praying for ears and **the Lord told me He'd heal me as I prayed with others.** So, I never actually received prayer for the ear. I just started praying for folks needing prayer. I don't know at what point it actually happened."

Ok, here are a few testimonies I would like to share:

- A lady I prayed with had pain in her right knee area. She came forward as a result of a Word of Knowledge. As I prayed for her she began to feel a lot of heat in her leg. She told me she had a metal plate in her thigh and some screws and things. The heat kept intensifying and I assured her that was a SIGN that Jesus was demonstrating His healing power to her. I asked her how she felt and she told me she was feeling "uneven". She went on to explain that she wore a shoe with a lift as one leg was shorter than the other. I asked her to take off her shoes and we discovered that **Jesus has grown out her leg.** She was able to walk straight and flat on the floor. She was amazed! We rejoiced and I prayed for her hips to also be properly aligned. Again she felt heat and the pain left her. Glory to God!
- Many fell under the power of the Lord during the meetings and rose up truly touched by His love.
- There was one woman I began to pray with for "more" of God although she also had physical problems. I took a hold of her hands but could not speak except in a whisper to the Father. As I did there was such a **holy Presence** that began to overshadow this lady that I knew I had to try to take my hands off of her. There were no words to say! Robin came by and also without touching her placed her hands near the woman and the holy presence increased and she fell under the power. I got to talk to her later and she agreed that something awesome took place and she knew it would overflow into the physical needs too!

- I also realized that the Father was at work healing broken hearts and emotional pain as He lead some to come up for prayer that involved a greater emphasis on the emotional healing.
 - One lady came up for healing of diverticulitis and for tumors on her uterus. As I prayed, again, heat came on her. She began to share about her tendency to worry and be fearful. The Holy Spirit showed me this was a root to the physical problems. I spent some time pouring truth into her and helping her break generational curses as she shared that she came from a "long line" of worriers! I saw her later in the day and **she made a point to come up to me and tell me that she really received a "deep healing"** as I prayed with her. Isn't HE wonderful!
 - What is so cool about a Glorious weekend like this is that His Glory was free to fall and manifest all over the Christ the King grounds. In the lunch room a couple of ladies drew me over to their table asking how they might get a copy of the Living for Jesus DVD. We offered the DVDs earlier in the meeting and had run out. After dealing with "business", I simply asked one of the gals how she was feeling. She explained that she had prayer for a pinched nerve in her neck but nothing happened. I offered to pray again for her.

As I was praying the Lord gave me the word "blame". I shared my impression by asking her how she got the pinched nerve. Long story. But bottom line, she was blaming herself and her brother. I lead her in repentance and forgiveness and she felt very comforted by the light of truth. The pain did not leave. Later that night I "happened" to sit down next to her. There was a word of Knowledge for neck pain. She wondered if she should get more prayer. My feeling is simple....Get as much prayer as you can until the healing comes or you go to be with Jesus. ☺

When she came back to the seat it was clear that while she was down under the power that the Lord had really touched her. She was still weeping. Her neck was not healed but the Lord showed her lots of areas of unforgiveness she needed to deal with. I was able to share with her about inner healing in the presence of the Father's love. She had never gone through any though she knew people who could pray for her. I counseled her to begin to take some steps and she knew this

would be the road she would walk that would also bring about her physical healing. This was the direction I felt from the Lord to take with her. She felt love

It was very late in the evening. Nevertheless, a huge part of what Living for Jesus International ministry has fun doing is IMPARTATION! The prayer team for all of the meetings was made up of over a dozen trained and willing local people. They not only prayed for people during the meetings but also gave themselves to extended times of one-on-one prayer during the afternoon "break" on Saturday. They were HUNGRY for impartation from the four of us and were not willing to say goodbye until they "got it".

So, we gathered them in an adjacent room, paired off, sort of, and blessed these dear people. Casey and I had a lot of fun praying and imparting together. One man who had been in ministry for a very long time simply said, "I am so very dry". "I have a deep dry well!" Well, his well got filled! We poured everything and every encouraging word the Father gave us for him into him!

Although I am blessed to impart/bless others with whatever Daddy God has given me I have the most fun imparting what I enjoy the most to others. And so, I imparted my child-like faith and obedience, my trust in Abba's love for me, joy, peace, and my ability to have fun with Papa, Jesus, and H.S. To more than one I exhorted them with something the Father told me years ago. "If you are not having "fun" in what I have called you to do there is too much of you in it!" Lights went on and people grabbed that nugget.

Ok, there's more but these are the things that are on the top shelf of my memory today. It was a great weekend and a foretaste of the "oneness" Jesus prayed that His followers would enjoy – just as He and the Father are ONE!

Casey:

This was one of those trips that you go on not knowing what to expect. All I knew was we were going to minister in a conference in a morning session. To be honest I didn't even know what the name of the conference was. I found that out on the plane ride there. Glory Explosion wow, well, that pretty much sums it up for me right there. My thought was that we were going to minister to them, and we did, but I think I brought way more home than I gave out. I love it when that happens. We were so blessed right off the get go when we were greeted at the air port by Frank. This man really has a heart of God and his wife is right

there with him. They treated us like we were long lost family coming home. They just opened up their house and said make yourself at home if you need or want anything just help yourself. It was very peaceful staying there. We were blessed.

Friday night started off the conference and the worship team that was brought in was AWESOME. You could tell they were all about entering God's Presence. I was so blessed to be able to fly my flags there and it didn't take long before I was lost in worship. I felt I could have gone on all night if they would have let me, but we were there to minister and pray for who ever needed prayer. Which brings me to my prayer partner. What a wonderful nice older lady she was a nun. Yep the only one in the building and I got to pray with her. Our styles were a bit different, but you know what that didn't matter one bit as the Holy Spirit flowed through both of us. We only got to pray for three ladies that all got touched by God. The first one was having pain in her back and the second one had pain in her knees. Both of them said the pain left their bodies and they felt great. The last lady just wanted a fresh touch from God. I love praying for those types of people. God had given me a prophetic word for her and then the nun got a word and spoke it over her as well. What a way to end the evening.

Saturday morning was our turn to speak and minister as Living for Jesus. Once again the worship was good and again I was able to worship with my flags. Tony shared about what we do when we go out on a mission trip and how God wants to use them the same way. It felt like everyone was on the edge of their seats hanging onto every word spoke. You could feel the anointing coming from Tony as he spoke and it kept getting thicker until it was time to release words of knowledge. It was cool we all had just about the same words to release. We each got a piece of the puzzle and when we put it altogether we got the major word of healing for that session. **That was arthritis and I saw everyone I prayed for receive healing.** I don't remember how many I prayed for, but I do remember everyone was healed. Thank you Jesus.

Saturday night was the close of the conference and a Rabbi Was speaking on the glory. What a great teaching he gave it was real good I mean real good. We were just part of the prayer team again tonight so we had to wait to be released to pray for people. Tony and I were a team and we got to pray for two people and I really don't remember too much of what they needed prayer for. Sorry but that happens sometimes.

When the evening was almost over most of the prayer team wanted impartation from our team. Well of course we would give them nothing but the best and that's just what we did. We gave everything away and they soaked up every bit. It was great.

Sunday morning we all slept in a bit. We didn't have a morning service to rush off to, but we still had church. As Tony wrote in his report Robin felt she

was to pray over us. It was better than awesome. Really no words can explain what the Holy Spirit was doing, but it was confirmation after confirmation as she prayed over us WOW I'll take more of that anytime.

Thank you Robin for allowing God to use you in that way. Now that's a great way to end a trip and a little more gravy we got to go to Vermont for brunch and even stopped for ice cream on the way home. Who cares it was only 58 degrees. Be Blessed!
