

Mission to the Philippines Magdum, Tagum City, Davao Del Norte

Village Outreach, Day 4, Friday, September 21, 2012

Casey:

What a great time we had this morning as we were out in the middle of some village doing outreach. We broke into teams as to cover the ground quicker. You know strike before the enemy knows you are there. The team they had me lead was a group of bible students who were imparted into last night and they are hungry to go use the new anointing they received. The first home we came to we asked if we could pray for anybody and an older man came out and said how much is this going to cost me? The students told him that we are not charging anybody that wants prayer. Freely we have received so freely we give. They told me that it is normally their tradition to pay for healing. Wow ok well not today, no charge Jesus paid the bill. Once he found out that there was no cost he welcomed us into his home and told us he is having back pain and pain in his leg. We told him that it was Jesus that was going to heal him and he just smiled. The students placed their hands on this man and instantly all the pain left his body.
