

Mission to the Philippines Living Word of God Ministries, Magdum, Tagum City, Davao del Norte

Pastor's Conference, Day 3, Thursday, September 20, 2012

Tony:

Thanks to all for interceding for this mission. What we saw God do today is monumental in the lives of these church leaders. This service started at 4pm and ended at 12 midnight, but for many of these believers there is no ending, only a beginning.

We had awesome praise and worship, listened to many people give testimonies of what God had done for them (we could have gone on for many hours just with this), moved into teaching on the prophetic, specifically words of knowledge and dreams and again the people were flipping out with excitement. We interpreted a few dreams for the people and oh my, you would have thought we had given them a million dollars.

I will just give a few of the testimonies I heard. 90% of the testimonies given I didn't know had happened since pastors and others were doing most of the praying:

A woman said that she had been suffering from a stroke that took out the left side of her body for the last number of years. She had continued to serve the Lord as much as possible with her limited use of her body, but everyday was a huge struggle for her. When she walked up no one would know that just a day ago she had to drag along her left leg as it was non-functional. She said INSTANTLY, when hands were laid on her, the power of God flowed thru her and she felt LIFE flow into her body and her left side became completely functional. Amazing! Hey, that wasn't the LFJ team praying, but one of the pastors simply believing God for the Anointing that has been given to him.

One lady was just so excited at what God had done. She shared how she had a large tumor on her body for a long time and as she got prayer it just INSTANTLY disappeared. She started pressing her body where it used to be and said, "it is just gone, it is gone, oh I am so happy to the Lord for what He has done!"

Testimony was given and confession made of how the church people would get mad at the pastors for not praying or ministering to them when they felt that the pastor should have. This was acknowledged as a common thing in the churches. BUT, today they have been awakened to understand it is Not the Pastor's job to do all the ministry. Today they understand it is their blessing to learn to do the work of the ministry and to do it. And many were just jumping with excitement that now they can do what they were created to do and had been expecting the pastors to do.

Testimonies given of the new liberty and freedom to be themselves and not put on pretense to perform but just grow in knowing the Lord and flow with the Spirit in this new authority and power they have.

One of the men leading worship, who is also a pastor, said he cannot wait to get back to his church to begin teaching and imparting to his people what they can do and they can minister for the Lord. He was going to lay his hands on every church member and impart to them.

When we got to the part of the evening when it was time to lay on hands for impartation there was a cracking in the air that was the sound of the power of God that had begun to flow into the atmosphere of this place. I have seen many powerful moves of God, but what I am about to share is really outside of words. When I told the people about how the Lord commissioned the disciples to go and that some of them would receive giftings, some callings released, some commissioning into service, some would be baptized in the Holy Ghost but we were confident that all would receive the Spirit's touch in some way. When I told them that, I really had no idea of the magnitude of what He was about to do. Casey and I would each lay hands on every person that wanted it to release the prophetic words and power that He had ordained for each of them to have.

Here goes: All the pastors and leaders lined up first and the Glory of the Lord was so thick, so strong, so powerful that people just started crying out to the Lord all over the place, long before we got to them. I had a picture of Isaiah, when he was before the Glory of the Lord and he felt his uncleanness. He was a mighty man of God and a Prophet of the Lord, but because he was so close to the Glory, every imperfection in him was evident and he felt it. I sensed this was how the impartation started. There was so much of the Glory of the Lord, so much of His Holiness, that the folks instantly saw: 1. Their need of cleansing, 2. Their need to live for Him, 3. Their need to repent and, 4. Their need to step into their calling

I had Casey go first and I spent most of the night on my knees, on the floor, moving from one to the next as most all were going to the floor during Casey's prayer for them. But what I got to see were men, woman, young adults and teenagers completely engulfed in an encounter with the Lord of their life that was radically changing them. Normally we will stop someone we are praying for from praying so they could receive, but we didn't stop anyone tonight. It was past weeping, it was past even wailing for many, every part of their beings were ENRAPPED with Jesus. There were cries for forgiveness everywhere. There were Baptisms in the Holy Ghost everywhere, many busting out in new heavenly prayer language, all the while tears pouring from their faces.

This was extremely Holy and extremely humbling to watch this happen to these beautiful Filipino people. No human interpreter, but oh what Holy Spirit did! This amazed me: most of the people did not understand English, as I released prophetic words and impartation prayer in each of their ears, as they were prostrate on the floor, again and again, they were acknowledging understanding me with shouts and words of "yes I agree" and "yes I receive" all with increased physical vibrations and increased tears.

Many had so much Glory on them that they couldn't get off the floor, it was like they were stuck. When people tried to "help" them up, 3 people couldn't do it. We told them it was the Kabod (the weighty, heaviness of the Glory of God).

I know that many received direct callings tonight into the service of the Lord. I know that Eternity broke into the earthly realm and there were angels delivering commissioning papers. I know it and the people receiving it know it. I do wish that there was a way I could describe this, but truly any word will be too small. Only time will tell what God has done.

Casey:

As I stare at this computer screen trying to figure out how I can accurately place into words what we saw and were allowed to be a part of last night. I am just sitting here drawing a huge blank. I can't remember ever being in a meeting like last night. We have been in a bunch of meeting where the awesome power of God shows up, but last night was totally different. Think Casey think...Holy Spirit help. How can I not belittle or make small of what we experienced.

Last night was our last meeting in this church so we always leave them with a full impartation of what God has given us. This is our most favorite time of any trip, this is when God pours into his children and gives them whatever gift He wants. It really is something to be a part of. The evening started out with awesome worship once again. All the flags were flying as who ever wanted to fly them was just coming up on their own to try it out. From what I was told all the local churches that were at this conference are all planning on making flags to worship within their own churches. That makes my heart glad to hear. When worship was finished Tony taught them on words of knowledge and dreams. They really loved the teaching again tonight. They really get in to the teaching sitting on the edge of their seats just hungry for the next word to be spoken. I just love the people here, they are so genuine. When the teaching was over they feed us a real nice dinner of rice and barbeque pork. One thing I can guarantee if you come here you will not go hungry. They are taking great care of us.

Impartation time was next and this is the part that I will try my best to explain what I experienced God do. We want to make sure everyone that wants the impartation gets it so we pray for each person one at a time. This way it God gives us a special word for them we can freely give it. Yeah, it takes a long time but it's all worth it in the end. Tony had me go first so I started to pray for the first person and all the sudden the power of God hit this person like lightning. She went right to the ground and was weeping out loud as it looked like she was being electrocuted. It's normal for us to see a few persons get hit with the power of God during impartation, but tonight I would say maybe only five persons didn't get taken out in the spirit even though it looked like a miracle they could still stand. The Power level in this place was so strong that even I was having a hard time standing in the power. This was only after the first few people that I prayed for. There were about 200 pastors, leaders & others wanting impartation tonight. God gave me a word for each one of them to. I guess in my own understanding this looked more like a wrecking service with no open space on the floor and everyone crying out for God as they laid on the floor weeping. This went for everyone young

and old alike. Even the Pastors were on the floor crying out. It was so Holy. The longer the evening went on and the longer the people waited the deeper the hunger became. So many of them were getting baptized in Holy Spirit fire tonight this is truly a move of God, wow. I kinda felt bad for Tony tonight because he spent most of the evening crawling around on the floor from person to person after I finished praying for them. I asked him if he wanted to go first so he could give his knees a rest but he just smiled and said "go get them buddy". This went on for hours or well at least until we were all done. Even then there were still a few persons on the floor out in the spirit. It just brought back to my remembrance when God brought me through my wrecking service and when I knew that He had called me for such a time as this. Thank you Jesus. So I guess if I had to sum up the evening...HOLY, HOLY,HOLY.
