Pastor's Conference Day 3

Tony:

Was there a movie called "The Longest Day"? If not, today would qualify. We awoke at 5am to the whole family singing praises unto the Lord and praying. This is a daily activity for this family of 9. They take their relationship with the Lord seriously. Then one of the little ones came in and said to me, "there is someone calling you outside, you need to go now!" We again had the people around them pray and all were miraculously healed. This was just a pleasant Holy Spirit surprise! We prayed for release of prophetic and words of knowledge.
