Open Air Crusade, Day 1

Tony:

We are humbled and learn so much from the people of this land, especially the family that is looking after us in their home. Another layer of a thankful spirit is being added to us these days.

We arrived at the crusade with a praise team of about 40 people giving glory to God. They went thru the introductions and HIS Presence was all around us. As the team prayed we were asking Holy Spirit for a single word to bring someone up for a demonstration. Now this is cool, He gave each of us the same word in a vision. I saw someone (I believed was a man) thrown off of a motorcycle and smash on the ground. After a short exhortation that this is all about Jesus and He is waiting to show Himself, we gave that word of knowledge. One man, from way in the back of the crowd, came up very slowly. He gave testimony of his motorcycle accident and for the last 5 years how he has been unable to work or even bend. He couldn't even turn from side to side. We prayed once and he began to do deep knee bends and said, "I am completely healed except for small small pain in my back!" One more round of prayer and he was completely, miraculously restored for everyone to see. Well, that was enough to give a call for salvation. There were hands up everywhere and asked them to come up and they RAN. They were coming so fast that they created a cloud of dust that was huge. I don't know what they were expecting but they were pushing each other to get to the front. We prayed with them (more than 1/2 of the people in attendance) and they attempted to get the names of everyone and quickly realized it was too big of a task, so they handed out cards for them to turn in tomorrow. We then invited all the pastors to line up and the people to come forward for prayer. The pastor I was with was very gently and loving, but yet very confident in the new authority he has in Jesus Name.

I will give you just one testimony of the man we started with: **He had a big tumor on his neck. It was so big that his neck was bent and head tilted at a 45 degree angle. He lived that way, unable to turn his head. We prayed and watched the tumor shrink, shrink, shrink until it was all gone! Then we prayed for his neck to straighten. We told him to begin to move his neck. The neck bones started cracking and popping, very loud. He got real big eyes and said "my neck bones are turning and cracking, Oh my God, the tumor is gone and my neck is straitening!" It was an awesome sight to see!** Praise God! There were a large number of

pastors praying and Holy Spirit was moving with a powerful Anointing, so prayer time was only like 1-1/2 hours. I would like to read the reports of the pastors to see all that God was doing tonight. There were many people that went up to the platform to give testimony, but there was no interpretation, just excited people, rejoicing in what God had done!

Tonight was our first night at the new crusade site in Makini. The stage that we are using is an old house foundation. I guess we heard right and God totally set free and healed this man as he just started to bend and stretch in way's he never could. The crowd started to clap and cry out praises to God. Then came the salvation call and hundreds came to answer the call. Wow that was cool. They all ran to the stage and created this huge dust cloud. It made it hard to breath. As they were receiving Jesus I took some photos with my new camera (thank you Julie). The picture that I took as all the hands were raised had this real bright white light show up just over the hands of the people. Louis looked at it and said it was the reflection off of the Land cruiser. It looked like a reflection off of the windshield or the chrome bumper it was that bright. So I didn't think too much of it, but I wanted to see if it was the truck for sure. You know just to check it out and what I seen was amazing. I mean totally awesome! It turned out to be the brightest orb that I have ever seen. It was just above the hands of one man and the light it is giving off actually was lighting him up. Way cool. had hundreds of orbs too but not like this one. God is here tonight. When the crowd was released to come to get prayer I teamed up with a female pastor.
