

## Mission to Mozambique October 2017

Tony:

As we went through the immigration inspection in the small Beira Airport, we picked up our baggage and were greeted by a very excited Pastor Baptista Magaia. He led us outside and what I thought were just local people doing whatever outside turned out to be a group of amazing singing believers blessing us with praise & worship and welcoming us here. Wow, what a blessing!

As they were trying to load us into a vehicle this young girl came up to me and handed me a piece of paper and kept pointing to it to get me to read it. As it looked at it, it was a statement that this young girl was a deaf mute and she was asking for donations to help her get her hearing and voice back. I said, I have something for you, but it is not money. What I have I give you and I put my hands on her ears and commanded them to open and BAM, they did. She said that she could now hear me. The others went off to the pastors home where we would be staying and I stayed back to wait for the flight on our Nigerian team member, August Awe. We found out her flight was delayed but before heading out I worked more with the deaf/mute young girl until she was speaking words! Glory Hallelujah! Now, that's a heck of a kickoff!

As we prepared for sleep on Friday night, there were a few people that came to us asking for healing. We accommodated them in Jesus Name! Mostly it looked like flu symptoms, they were very weak, but ALL healed!

The next morning we were told there was a small church that just had the Pastor go home to be with the Lord and they wanted some preachers to come and minister to the flock. I was asked if we would go. Of course, off we went to this tiny church with partial canvas roof to bless these folks.

We taught a little, gave words of knowledge and all the people got healed. I had the people getting healed do the praying for the next person and helped them to see how easy it was. First was an older man that had bad back and neck. He was one of the leaders and was in shock. He was quite emphatic in Portuguese about what Holy Spirit had just done for him! All prayed for were miraculously healed! The people were astonished at what they saw! Then they went on to dance (this is a very big thing here for them to dance in unison at a pace that will wear out those not in shape in a matter of seconds. I mean, you gotta see the intensity of this! An ultra workout for sure!). I gave it a shot but had to fairly quickly head for a seat.

Saturday evening first outdoor crusade. It would take up about 10 pages to write about all the miracles I saw. There were not only so many, but it happened so fast. Seemed like an anatomy class could define it all. But there was lots of rejoicing in the house.

## TESTIMONIES

Sunday:

Sunday morning. We could have had a team of 50 people and a church for everyone to go to for preaching and ministry today. So, all of our team went to a different church and brought the message and led the ministry. They took me off to 2 churches, first one to just bless them and then on to the second for ministry. There were about 200 people in this church and they told me that there will be a couple of preachers today and “which position would I like, first or second up?” I thought, now that is interesting. I said, “I will take the first position!” I knew that once I moved into Holy Spirit demonstration that would take the service to the end. Well sure enough. I could see that many had never heard the simple Gospel of Jesus Christ before, so I simply got into it as Holy Spirit led. The people were pretty amazed, then I joined Holy Spirit in demonstrating what Jesus has done for us.

Tony:

Rest of the Mission: Teachings received with joy, outreaches to the streets with the folks that were in the conference and they saw how easy it is to go to the streets with Holy Spirit to show the Real Jesus. Lots of salvations with a demonstration of power. Those going out had activated the Truth we taught! Many miracles, many healings, many set free from all sorts of issues, but what happened at the end of this mission sums up for me what this mission was about. We are exhorted by Jesus to make disciples and sent them out to as far away as the ends of the earth for them. It's a mission impossible for us in our selves, even in our religious selves, it just isn't going to happen. The beauty is that Jesus said “and lo I will be with you always!” Hallelujah, we don't need to go it alone!

So, it's the last night of our stay in Mozambique. In the morning we leave for the airport to make the long trek back home. The team has gotten cleaned up and some in the process of putting their things in order to prepare to go and some even are ready to lay down in bed for the remainder of the night. When our host's son comes to me and says “there is a pastor here and he is begging that the team come to his church now. He said his church is full of people wanting us to minister to them.” I said ok, I will got out and talk to this pastor. I listened to him border on begging us to come, pleading that his

people need to see Jesus as we have presented Him! I checked with the team members and strange enough we were in consensus that we were not to go, but that we needed to encourage our host's son to go. He was in all the meetings and was passionate for Christ. It was just generally considered that he was a young, untrained man and could not do what we had been teaching. That it needed to be our team. So, I went back out to talk to this pastor and told him that this young man has the same Holy Spirit we do and has heard and seen the Truth and he could go. The pastor kept saying "no, it must be you and the team!" Finally he understood that God was going to demonstrate What We Came to the Nation to do: And that is to Train and Equip believers to do the same works as Jesus! The pastor said ok, if that is all we can get, then we will take him. But the pastor was obviously disappointed and thinking in his mind that the evening was going to be a bomb.

Are you ready for the testimony? The next morning we heard what happened. This young man went there and said he could see the disappointment not only in the pastor but in the faces of all the people there. He said "My God, it was amazing, I knew I could do what the team did so I said I am here as part of the Living for Jesus International team but most of all representing Jesus Christ. I brought my partner with me, Holy Spirit!" I gave a word of knowledge and the person received an instant miracle. Then I was told that there were 2 ladies in the front row that were crippled and could not walk. While everyone looked on, I looked at them and out of my mouth comes: "In the name of Jesus, get up and walk! I went to them, took their hands and pulled them up. An Amazing thing happened, each of them began walking and the people were really open to hear the Gospel. I preached the Truth of what Jesus had done and there were salvations and all healed!"

From that, word spread of what this young man had done, and he began to receive invitations from other churches to come and teach them this Gospel! Ok, this is what I am talking about, we are leaving behind people that will change Mozambique! Those who know the Same Jesus lives in them!

## **Team Testimonies**

### **Friday Our Arrival**

Sally Drost:

We arrived around 2:00pm in Beira, Mozambique, after a long trip starting at 11:00am on Wednesday from Port Charlotte, FL. We spent the rest of the day getting acquainted and basically resting from the trip.

We were greeted by the church choir which sang a cappella with rhythmic dancing. The voices were outstanding in their harmony and ability to improvise. We were honored by them!

We came home to the pastor's home to find a nice bedroom that had just been built on to the house for us with a real toilet. There are two double beds in it and mosquito netting was attached to the ceiling to cover the beds. No closet or place to hang our clothing but I will just live out of my suitcase. No problem.

My major impression was how loving the people are. They give us a lot of respect and are so thoughtful and kind. They have welcomed us beautifully and I look forward to the six days we will be here.

Dick Evans:

The trip from the airport to the pastors home was our first look at the area and an experience with the driving being on the wrong side of the road! LOL. We were greeted at his home by many children anxious to see us and touch us. You could easily sense the love and excitement in all of them and the grownups, too.

Before we went to bed that night, a young woman was having a fever and a headache. Commanded the headache to go, the pain to leave and for sinus to clear.

### **Saturday Morning**

Dick Evans:

The woman we prayed for last evening for a fever still had no fever but no energy. We commanded strength and energy and as she got up from her seat and was full of energy.

We went to a small church a few miles away. They were in need of prayer as the pastor of the church had recently passed away.

Pastor Tony gave a message on what Jesus has given to us through the Holy Spirit's renewal of our minds. The Holy Spirit demonstrated His healing power and everyone who came forward was healed.

Sally Drost:

Before I began to pray, the Lord gave me a word of knowledge concerning "lungs."

The first baby I held had asthma. As soon as I came against that spirit, the baby began to kick and scream then I loosed peace and health into him and he fell asleep in my arms. When I returned the baby to its mother, I knew he was healed. I also prayed for a child for her eyes and two more babies. Then I remembered how God impressed me last week, as I prayed for Mozambique, that I would have more children to pray for this trip.

I also prayed for a lady with pain in her chest and abdomen. She left with a huge smile on her face. I didn't need an interpreter to know all pain was gone.

Gem Crilly:

Today we awoke around 6am to bright daylight which was good because last night we could not get the light to work where Sally, Augusta and I were sleeping. After breakfast we headed to New Creative Church which was in Beira, Mozambique. It was a very small church with maybe 100 people. We sang and danced before Tony spoke and then asked for words of knowledge. Each of us had a word and those affected came forward. I was able to lay hands for legs, headache, earache, shoulders, chest pain, ankle pain, backs and stomachs. All were healed by Jesus.

Dick Evans:

Tony preached short message on holy spirit being in born again believers. Than he told them that holy spirit wanted to demonstrate.

We all laid hands on the sick individually and all were healed. Here are what I recall from those i prayed with

A few with Headaches came up and were instantly healed as i touched there head and commanded it to go.

A man asked for prayer for his ears. He did not speak English so i was not certain what the problem was but God knew. I commanded total healing and restoration and when I removed my hand he smiled and I knew he was healed.

A couple had pain in their backs and with a quick command all their Backs were healed. Set free from all pain.

A little woman came to me because of ashima. I laid my hands on her and commanded the spirit of asthma to leave and for her lungs to be clear and breathing free. I had her take a couple deep breaths. She was totally free..

A man came and told me that he had pain in his big toe. And his right hip. I placed my hand on his toe and then his hip commanding all pain to go. Immediately it left.

A woman with stomach issues came to me. I laid my hand on her and commanded whatever was causing the issues to leave.

Another woman came to me with breathing issues. I laid my hand over hers on her chest and commanded clear lungs and free breathing. Then I had her take deep breaths. She was free.

Sally Drost:

Pastor Tony gave a message at New Created Church on what Jesus has given to us through the Holy Spirit's renewal of our minds. The Holy Spirit demonstrated His healing power and everyone who came forward was healed. There were about 100 or more people there.

### **Saturday: First Night of the outside crusade**

At around 4:00 we left for a crusade in town on the grounds of Munhava Public School. There ended up being, it seemed, at least 500 people. They kept coming. The whole team was totally busy praying for at least an hour.

There were so many people who received healing that we couldn't possibly list them all. There were many healings from headaches and abdominal pains in which the pain left immediately. There were only two who needed to be prayed for twice. Many healings from aches and pains all over different parts of the body occurred. One came seeking healing from the love of alcohol. Children came with ailments, bumps and bruises --- all healed.

Then the children began to come for hugs and blessings --- hundreds of them. We hugged for twenty minutes and blessed each one. I remembered when Jesus said to let the children come. God's love flowed!

After the healings, the same dance praise team that started the session ended with another hour of praise. We praised God with them. It was an awesome time! When we left, the people were still celebrating.

Gem Crilly:

This evening we went to Munhava Public School grounds where there was about 500 people waiting to hear Tony and be healed. I had a great time dancing with all the children they are so loving and wanted continual hugs and blessings. What a blessing they gave me. It was impossible to say how many people I laid hands on tonight. I can tell you it looked like everyone of the 500+ came forward for healing, adults and children alike. Tony, Augusta, Sally, Dick and myself were continually laying hands till everyone was touched and all received complete healing. I laid hands for eyes, headaches, mind, ears, mouth pain, chest, palpitations, stomachs, legs and feet. A few said they suffered from nightmares so I cast out anything not of God refilling with the peace, joy, love and light of Jesus. By the time I finished praying for people I think I had covered every part of the body multiple times. Jesus is so awesome He healed everyone I laid hands on. Thank you Jesus

Dick Evans:

After a short message, Tony called for words of knowledge. I had a word for a toothache. They came forward. Many had issues and Jesus healed them all! Many teeth were healed pain. Gone instantly. Headache gone. Backs healed with all pain taken away. Many came forward with pain in their knees. As we commanded their pain to go it left instantly.

A couple of people had heart issues. We laid hands on them for a strong heart Eyes were healed. A man came up with pain in his left thigh. I was told the doctor could not fix it. One touch and a command for the pain to go and he was free. Many came to know Jesus as their Lord.

## **Sunday Morning**

Sally Drost:

The five members of the mission team were assigned to five different churches in order to give the Sunday messages. I was a guest speaker at Pastor Noah's church. Five pastors from different areas attended. After I gave the message, I invited the pastors to help me lay hands on people and pray for healing during ministry since there were so many who came forward.

Everyone who was touched received healing. About 80 people came forward for prayer. There were healings of abdominal pain, sore throats, and headaches in my area. It was a joy to watch the pastor's do the praying! Thank you, Jesus!

One demon manifested and tried to put on a show so I ran over to the commotion and took authority. The woman became free and gave me a big hug. Thank you, Jesus! I received a word for one of the pastors. When he heard it, tears came to his eyes. I could see he was encouraged.

When the service ended at 3:00, we walked down the street to a home and had a meal. We walked back to the host pastor's (Pastor Noah) house. At the home was a young man with an injured foot so the interpreter, who had been with me earlier, laid hands on him for healing. It was so great to see that young man apply what he had heard earlier in the day! That's why we're here. To show others their inheritance in Christ.

Gem Crilly:

This morning the team headed in different directions to teach and preach at a different church. I was invited to preach in Pastor Baptista, our host, pastors church, Flock of God Church. I rode 1/2 way there in a jeep style vehicle then Pastor Baptista picked me up on his motorcycle and took me the rest of the way. We arrived to a full church of about 200+ people all singing praises. After singing and dancing I was introduced to speak. Pastor had asked me to make it short so I condensed what I was going to say. Then when I had finished I turned to the Pastor who was interpreting for me and asked if that was short enough? He said "no keep going" so I did. After I was done Pastor asked all who wanted healing to come forward and everyone got up and came forward. I started laying hands and the healing's came quickly. There were so many people waiting to be healed so I asked the 4 guest pastors to come help. Three came forward and I demonstrated how so the each laid hands and the person was healed then the fourth Pastor also came and laid hands. I told them to continue and they did. I also had a young woman lay hands on an old lady. The old lady was so thrilled at seeing the person healed she did not even wait for me to tell her to continue she just went ahead and laid hands. The healings were quick and everyone was healed. Thank you Jesus.

Dick Evans:

We were each driven to 1 of 5 churches to preach. I was driven to the Evangelical Sanity Christian Church with Pastor Dango. It was located in the middle of what looked like hundreds of small cement block houses. The three wheeled taxi drove up to the church and I was greeted with a choir singing praises.

Holy Spirit preached through me to about one hundred at this little church. Little in size but large in spirit. The love of god was evident in the people. I talked about being born again. About being doers of the word. About them being a door that Jesus walks

through to reach the people. About laying hands on the sick. I finished to let holy spirit minister to them. For him to demonstrate to us his healing power. I asked for anyone with a pain in their back to come forward. There were many and every one was miraculously healed instantly. Then others were invited forward and I believe the rest of the church came. I cannot remember all the details. Many of the women were carrying infants or young children. Here are some of what i saw holy spirit heal.

Backs one right after the other. I just placed my hand where the pain was and commanded it to leave. In every case it left right away. Headaches in many some with heart issues as well. Commanded the heart to be healed and blood pressure to be normal. Commanded strong hearts and perfect blood flows and pressure.

A few women with stomach issues. One woman went outside and threw up totally healed. Thank you Jesus for her deliverance. There were quite a few with pain in their legs. In each case I laid my hands on the spot of the pain. One quick "pain leave" and it was done.

A man had pain in both Toes. I held his hands and commanded the pain to leave. He checked and all pain was gone. Prayers for exams and good grades. Toothache in many women. One touch and the pain was gone. Asthma in many babies and a few adults. I commanded the spirit of asthma out and had them take deep breaths.

Baby crown not completely grown. There was a small space at the top of his head that was white where the skull had not knitted together. I placed my hand on the spot and told the bone to knit together. On the way home we stopped and I preached for a few minutes at another church.

### **Sunday: Second Night of the outside crusade**

Sally Drost:

That evening we held another crusade at Munhava School. About 300 people were there with many, many children. After Dick gave the message and we ministered healing to almost all of them. Many people became healed from pain in heads, throats, abdomens, stomachs, and teeth. Again, we had the help of interpreters and they even laid hands on people. There was much rejoicing!

Gem Crilly:

This evening we all went to the crusade again. After singing and worship and a message by Dick we went into laying hands healing. There were so many people a lot

of them children. I had the interpreter lay hands on his mothers back and she was healed. He continued laying hands.

I also asked one Pastor to lay hands and he said "I don't do that" so I told him I knew that and that I don't do it either, it's Jesus that does it and Jesus is waiting for you to use this hand. I held up his hand and before he could argue any more I asked for someone with a headache to come forward and they did. I told the Pastor lay hands I will tell you what to say so he did and repeated my words. The woman said her headache was gone but the Pastor asked her a total of 3x before accepting she was healed. The next person he prayed for he only asked 2x then after that he accepted that they were being healed.

There were so many I could never count but the complaints are almost always the same stomach, feet, teeth, headache, legs, chest, heart pot blessings for the baby. One woman said she was baron so I prayed for her womb. Also a few children I could feel their fever lessened after prayer. Thank you Jesus for all the healing and blessings.

Dick Evans:

When we arrived we were surrounded by children greeting us. It was another large crowd. I was privileged to give the message and to call them forward for healing. The team had words of knowledge for stomachs and neck aches. Many pressed in to the team for Jesus to heal them. Holy Spirit touched each and every person and they were instantaneously healed.

There were so many i cannot remember them all. Headaches instantly left confirmed by the smiles on their face and the thumbs up as He healed them.

Many came up with problems in their stomachs. One women said it was moving from one place to another. All the others left with their stomachs healed. This one needed a spirit cast out. We touched her where the pain was and commanded the spirit out in the name of Jesus. She left free.

A few women had heart and headache issues. I commanded strong hearts and perfect blood pressure. Then told the headache to go. It left right away. A number of people had toothaches. A held their jaws and commanded healing in the teeth and for pain to go. They checked their teeth and pain was no more. And then the backs and legs. In each case i touched the place the pain was manifesting and commanded it to leave. Everyone was healed.

As we sat waiting for the crusade to wind down there was much singing and dance the little children came to us for a touch. Thank you Jesus for using the team in a mighty way! Many came to know Jesus as their Lord.

Before the night ended, Pastor Baptista introduced the team and the people sang to us chanting our names after we were introduced. Pastor Tony... Pastor Dickie... Pastor Sally... Pastor Gemy... Pastor Augusta...

### **Monday Pastor's Conference Day 1**

Sally Drost:

We arrived at Pastor Baptista's Flock of God Church around 10:30 am to begin the pastor's seminar on healing evangelism. Many of the pastors were already seated and ready to hear what Tony would teach them.

It was enjoyable to watch the faces change from stoic to joyful as they heard the message. For many, it was like a light went on.

After the first teaching about what Jesus did for us and testimonies of healings, ministry time began. The team stood in front and waited for those with needs to come for healing. About twenty came forward. I received a word of knowledge about eyes needing healing. A pastor I met yesterday came to me for prayer for his eyes. I prayed against eye pain and for perfect vision. I noticed later that he had discarded his glasses. Hallelujah!

A young lady carrying a baby asked for prayer for her baby and pain in her chest. When we were finished, she gave me a thumbs up and a broad smile. I knew she was grateful for the healing.

Another young lady had neck and leg pain. She walked away with no pain.

A young man came forward with a specific request for a word from the Lord. I prayed to myself, "Help, Lord; please give me words." The words of encouragement to him were the fact that God was going to make him a leader in His army --- a General. He looked at me with amazement and said, "My name is General!" I encouraged him to stay close to the Lord so he could hear His voice. He truly was touched in a different way.

Another young man asked for a change in his life so we prayed and I encouraged him.

A short time later, lunch was served in bowls to all 70+ people. We enjoyed rice and beans soup.

Then Tony taught session 2. He spoke on faith and the new covenant. He demonstrated the way to pray for healing.

When people came forward for healing prayer, Tony directed the pastors to pray and the team to help them. All ailments were healed and it was evident that the pastors were pleased.

As they said good-bye to all of us individually by passing us in a line and shaking hands

Gem Crilly:

This morning we went to Pastor Baptista's, Flock of God Church for a Pastor Conference. Pastor Tony preached to about 70 pastors telling them the truth about God. It is amazing to sit and watch God at work. When Tony starts to talk the pastors, both male and female, sit with confused looks on their faces. They are not quite sure what is coming. About 1/2 way through the teaching you start to see a few pastors who are beginning to receive the truth and by the end of the teaching a lot more. Today it did not take that long for some pastors to receive and by the end of the first session (1/2 day) there were many pastors who were excited to hear the truth. We took a break for lunch which consisted of rice and a topping of a bean, cabbage and sauce mix. It was good but tasted better with the hot pepper mix they gave us.

After lunch Tony continued with the teaching and then had us show some pastors how to lay hands. Some people came up for healing and we were able to help the pastors lay hands. All were healed. Tony then did a question-answer session which was good.

Dick Evans:

We arrived late morning to a room of about forty pastors. Tony did two teaching sessions at the end of which he invited people up for prayer. Tony explained how to pray by commanding and demonstrated with the words of knowledge that came forth from the team.

Then the team prayed for many in the room which had grown to about eighty men and women.

Here is some of what i saw holy spirit do as I laid hands on those that came forward.

Backs were healed instantly as they moved like they were using a hula-hoop.

Feet pain left as each jumped up and down. You could tell what God did as their smiles grew wide.

One came up with a toothache. I laid my hands on her mouth and commanded the pain to go and for healing in the tooth. All pain left.

A woman brought a baby with asthma. I commanded the spirit of asthma to go. Could not see immediate results but the child was very peaceful.

A woman came up with head trauma the result of an accident last month. I laid my hand on her head and commanded the head healed and for whatever was damaged to be restored. After a couple of times she pronounced she felt much better.

We broke for lunch and they fed all of us. Then Tony started Session 2

After the last teaching for today Tony called up anyone needing prayer. The team members each had an interpreter. There was a line extending across the entire front of the church.

One man had a headache and stomach pain as well as pain in both knees. I placed my hand on his stomach and commanded the pain to go. Also spoke to the head and knees. The stomach pain left. Then I touched both knees and commanded the pain to go. He checked his legs by jumping up and down. They were healed. Then I had my interpreter to lay his hand on the man's head and command the pain to go. He was totally healed.

A man came with a fast heart. I placed my hand over his heart and commanded a strong heart beating normally. The man declared it slowed down. Another stomach pain instantly healed. Same result with a woman with a headache. Instant.

Man with breathing issues. Could not take deep breaths. I laid my hand on his chest and commanded his breathing to be free and his lungs clear. Had him take a couple of deep breaths. His breathing was free.

When he finished the teaching he called anyone needing healing to come up. Then he called for five pastors to come up to pray. Each of us took a pastor and led them through healing those that came up.

Feet seemed to be the issue this afternoon. The first two were healed quickly as the pastor placed his hand on their foot and commanded healing. Again they jumped up and down and the healing manifested. Then one needed to be prayed four times. The healing came and the pastor learned first hand about being persistent until the manifestation comes.

One man appeared to have one leg shorter than the other. I had him sit in a chair and extend his legs. Sure enough one leg was about an inch shorter than the other. Holy Spirit grew out his short leg as i commanded. I also commanded all pain to leave. Had him stand up and check it. He cautiously moved his legs up and down. All of a sudden he moved them and faster. All the pain he had been experiencing in his left knee was gone! Thank you Jesus.

The session ended with a question and answer time where Tony was able to clarify a number of points.

## **Tuesday Pastor's Conference Day 2**

Gem Crilly:

Today is Tuesday and the 2nd day of the Pastor Conference. Today there were pastors, having traveled very far and arriving last night, had not heard what was said on the first day. Tony took a little time to recap what he had covered the day before and both first and second day pastors were happy to hear the truth of God's word. We then stopped for breakfast which was a buttered roll. They did offer sardines to put on the rolls but it was too early for any of us. They finally did bring coffee for us to have with breakfast. It was about 11:00 am with some of us up since 6:00 am.

After lunch Pastor Augusta spoke, then Dick then Tony started his second day of teaching. We stopped for lunch about 2:00 pm. Sally gave the blessing and they offered rice and fish. They again had coffee, a big deal for some of us.

After lunch Tony again spoke and at the end he had those needing healing come forward. This time he asked for interpreters to come help us understand what was being asked for and also pastors who wanted to learn to lay hands to come up so we could show them. The interpreter that came to me was young, possibly in his 30's, and I asked him if while he was interpreting he wanted to lay hands. He immediately told me that it was not his gift. I laughed and told him being a Christ believer the Holy Spirit in him will give him the gift as he needs it. Still not convinced I said "you understand

electric runs thru a wire" he said yes. I told him the Holy Spirit in him is like the electricity. Then I explained that without a lightbulb the electricity is no good. He understood that. I told him that his hand was the lightbulb the Holy Spirit would use. He now understood and I helped as he laid hands. All he prayed for Jesus healed. Thank you Jesus.

Sally Drost:

We headed to IFRED Church for the second day of the seminar at 9:15 am. We were greeted warmly. Today the pastors, who came by train, joined us. There was a total of 79 people in attendance. We praised God!

Tony taught three sessions today. One session was held before the breakfast of bread and butter, coffee, and juice. He summarized yesterday's teaching for those who had not been there.

After we ate, Augusta was invited to speak. Then Dick also spoke. Both did a great job! Tony then did session two and taught about the keys to the kingdom and how God has given us so much power and authority in him to overcome all the power of the kingdom. Then he gave a demonstration of healing prayer. Powerful stuff. Holy Spirit was evident in all activities. The bonding among the people continued.

Lunch came next. Rice, tomatoes, onions and fish were on the menu. They even brought coffee for us Americans.

Then Tony gave the last message of the day and called for a ministry time of healing prayer. Many pastors lined up for prayer and each one of us had an interpreter. There were many healings. I prayed for two people with back pain, two people for overall pain, one with neck pain, and for a pastor with difficulty in breathing. The last one needed prayer twice but all were healed. We arrived back home at our host's place around 4:30 pm.

Dick Evans:

I did a review before lunch of how to lay hands on the sick. I called for someone with a back pain. I placed my hand on his back and commanded the pain to leave. He checked his back and some pain was still there. I talked about being persistent and prayed again. When he checked, all pain was gone. Then I reviewed the steps.

### **Wednesday Pastor's Conference Day 3**

Gem Crilly:

Today was the third day of the conference and it was exciting to see the pastors eager to hear Tony speak. When Tony talked, everyone listened eagerly. As usual you could see the revelation of the Word touch the people's Spirit. We stopped for breakfast which again consisted of a buttered roll and coffee or juice. Tony then spoke again before asking for words of knowledge. I had a word for neck pain and many came forward. I began laying hands saying only "pain be gone in Jesus name" and the pain left them. After about 6 people, I had the new interpreter lay hands saying only the same short sentence. All pain was gone in the 4-5 people he laid hands on so I had another Pastor do the same. They were all thrilled to see how God used them.

We then stopped for lunch which actually had some chicken with the rice. We also had coffee or juice. During lunch I had the opportunity to finally bless the man that 2 days earlier the Lord had told me to bless. Then the Lord told me that there was a man who had been praying for help and was in a state of despair. I called the man outside gave him a spiritual blessing and a small financial one. Later I was watching him and his whole demeanor had changed. He now had a big smile and was singing and dancing praises to the Lord when before he had not even smiled.

Again Tony talked and then we did prophetic prayer on each person but there were so many people I only did about 75% of them. When we finished they asked us to stand in a line. They then presented each one of us women with a kapula wrapper and the men with a kapula sash. They then invited us to dance. While dancing the men picked Tony up and started dancing with him in the air. I was laughing so hard when all of a sudden I too was in the air. The women had picked me up. They danced around with Tony and I in the air for what seemed like a long time then they finally put us down and the music stopped. We were then finished with church for the day.

Around 7:00 pm two cars came to pick us up and take us to Gisela and her husband's house for dinner. Also joining us was Pastor Okey and Cynthia, she did all the cooking. The meal was very good and the fellowship was wonderful. Praise God for a wonderful day and evening.

Sally Drost:

We arrived at IFRED Church around 9:30 am. After praise songs and dances, Tony began teaching on deliverance, freedom in Christ, sin, and receiving from God during night watches, etc.

We had a ministry time just before lunch. Before I prayed for a lady with hip and heal her pain, God gave me a word of knowledge that she had bone spurs. The Lord took all pain away and her face lit up. Another woman had neck pain. She had full mobility of her neck when Jesus finished with her.

A man with neck problems approached. I received a word of knowledge that he was under stress so prayed for peace as well as healing. I could practically feel his shoulder area lose its tightness. He moved his neck around and we knew Jesus had healed him. A man with a headache came for prayer and Jesus took care of him. No pain as he walked away.

We had a lunch of rice and chicken that was delicious. Mango juice added more variety.

Then at 1:30 pm Tony taught his last session at the pastors' conference. It focused on not being under the law but under grace. The pastor's were highly encouraged to be transparent with their people and to put aside do's and don'ts. He reiterated and emphasized what it means to walk in the Spirit.

We ended by praying for each person there. Then a time of celebration and presenting gifts came. A few of the pastors spoke thanks to the team. It was easy to see they were touched by our ministry. Tomorrow some pastors will join us as we take God's love into neighborhoods from house to house.

Dick Evans:

After the last teaching for today, Tony called up anyone needing prayer. The team members each had an interpreter. There was a line extending across the entire front of the church.

One man had a headache and stomach pain as well as pain in both knees. I placed my hand on his stomach and commanded the pain to go. Also spoke to the head and knees. The stomach pain left. Then I touched both knees and commanded the pain to go. He checked his legs by jumping up and down. They were healed. Then I had my interpreter to lay his hand on the man's head and command the pain to go. He was totally healed.

A man came with a fast heart. I placed my hand over his heart and commanded a strong heart beating normally. The man declared it slowed down.

Another stomach pain instantly healed. Same result with a woman with a headache. Instant.

Man with breathing issues. Could not take deep breaths. I laid my hand on his chest and commanded his breathing to be free and his lungs clear. Had him take a couple of deep breaths. His breathing was free.

### **Thursday Last Day Outreach**

Sally Drost:

We arrived at the church around 10:00 am, waited for our host to arrive with a breakfast of buttered bread.

Our host pastor gave a message and then Tony introduced the visitation of the neighborhoods and what we are to do.

Going out to homes in the neighborhoods of IFRED Church was a fantastic blessing! God's love flowed. We left the church around 12:00 noon and returned around 2:00 pm.

All the people we talked with were born again. But some had strayed from the church. By the time we left, they said they really wanted to come back to church because they saw God's love in us. These words of many were not solicited but just came out of hearts touched by God's love.

Many healings occurred in the homes: heart palpitations, knees, ankles, headache, etc. The first home we visited had a baby who needed a healing from a rash on her scalp. By the time we left, it was obvious the rash was fading. Another home had a beautiful family of seven children. Everyone was present and we were able to bless them all. Smiles reflected a touch from God after we prayed for provision, wisdom in finances, a job for a teen and peace. I felt God's love pour into that situation. Many homes were blessed with peace, provision needs, job needs, etc. One woman stood in proxy for her sick husband who worked in another city.

In our group were five pastors, two there for first day, and they got it! Fantastic prayer warriors!

They took over after three demonstrations and did everything that was taught at the seminar. They only had to be reminded about a few technicalities. One of the new pastors was begging God and I told him (through an interpreter) about the power and

authority we have been given. One of the other pastors completed the explanation and the interpreter told me what he said. It was what he had learned at the seminar. I praised God!

We returned to the church filled with God's love. A testimony time was encouraging to them all and to the team. We ended the day with hugs and goodbyes and thank you to the team. The visit from the mission team truly encouraged that part of the body of Christ.

Gem Crilly:

Today is our last day. We met the other pastors at the church. Tony explained to all the pastors what we were going to do when we got to the village. We each got an interpreter, I had P., he was 33 years old, married with a 4 year old son. He was still trying to learn English so communication was a little hard but his English was far better than my Portuguese which is zero. We were each to take 6 people and meet in front of the church before heading out. Pictures taken we headed to the village.

We went to each house that did not already have a missionary team. I looked at my team and realized somehow I had ended up with 12 people. I had each one take a turn walking up to a house and asking if anyone needed healing. That person laid hands for healing and truly everyone that was prayed for received healing. Then they asked if the person was a Christian. We had 7 people accept Christ.

Two interesting things; 1. At one house we walked into the yard and the lady said her back had been hurting her but as soon as we walked in she said the pain left without us even praying. She asked for a blessing on her house which we did. 2. As we walked up this lane a man on the right came out to ask us to come into his yard. The interpreter, also a pastor, said no. I said yes. He said this lady in the house on the left needs healing so we went to the lady on the left. Her stomach pain left and her frozen shoulders let loose and she was able to move both arms. Thank you Jesus. She then gave her life to the Lord.

When we came out the man on the right had come back into his yard. I told P who was walking ahead now we had to pray for these people but he said they were drunks and we shouldn't. I explained to all the pastors we carry the light of Jesus and no place is too dark for us to go. I asked the man if we could come in and he was very happy. He spoke English and told me 4 of the 6 wanted to stop drinking and give their lives to the Lord. We prayed for each one first then they gave their lives to the Lord. It was amazing to see. Two of them wanted nothing to do with God.

When we got outside I explained how God had already chosen those 4 to enter His kingdom. We should never let darkness put fear upon us or stop us. They were so happy to see what had just happened and the lesson they learnt. I went on to explain that by going out as we were doing people who got saved would also ask what church they could go to and this would multiply their flock. We did not get more than 200 feet when a young man of about 18 stopped us. He smelled of alcohol, a large problem here I'm told, he told us he wanted to stop drinking and to accept Christ. After we finished praying and bringing him into the Kingdom I explained he should pray to God for strength to continue to not drink. He then asked where a church was he could go to? I had a private giggle to myself, God never fails us.

It was so hot and we were late heading back. At one point I actually got so lightheaded from the heat my legs buckled. We were in a house that was like an oven. As soon as I got outside and the breeze hit me I felt much better. The young ladies that were with us took great care of me making sure to cover my head and hold my hands all the way back. The love of these people goes beyond words. I am happy and sad to be leaving tomorrow but I miss my Sheena Cherry Berry and my Biscuit Nugget Jr, two cats, and will be so happy to see them. May God Bless these people abundantly.

Dick Evans:

We met at a different church today for the last day of the conferences. There were a few new people today and the church was full.

Tony began the day teaching on deliverance Jesus style. When he finished this session we prayed for people without an interpreter. The people made known their needs and we laid hands on them

A man with pain in his Right thigh. I placed a hand on his leg commanding the pain out. I had him jump up and down and he gave me a thumbs up. The pain was gone.

Another man had pain in his shoulder. I placed my hand on the shoulder and commanded pain out. It got a little better but was still there. I had him stretch out his arms and one arm was a couple inches shorter than the other. I commanded it to grow and it immediately did. I had him raise his arms and he gave me the thumbs up. Yay God.

Then a woman with pain under her left breast. I had her out her hand there and I put my hand on hers. Then I commanded the pain to go. She checked and gave me a thumbs up.

Another person had back pain. A quick prayer commanding it out and he was healed

A few came forward needing Dream interpretation. We listened to their dreams and told them its meaning. Thank you Holy Spirit for showing us the answer.

Next we left the church and split up into groups made up of one of the team and a group of pastors to go to a village and minister with them practising what they had learned. My group went into one home and the man had back pain and hands that he could not clench and were without feeling. As he tried to clench his hands the pain would increase in his back. We laid hands on his back and commanded the pain to go. It left until he tried his hands. We held his hands and commanded total healing and for the feeling to come back into his hands. He was then able to clench his hands without the pain.

One woman had had a growth removed from her right armpit area. Since then she could not raise her arm and therefore could not return to her work in the fields. She was anxious and had a fast heartbeat. We commanded the heartbeat to be normal and it slowed right down. Then we placed our hand on the affected area under her arm and commanded total restoration and for all pain to leave. When she raised her arms the pain left and she had full mobility of the right arm.

We went to many other homes and saw headaches leave and strength regained. Heartbeats were made normal. Flu healed. And many homes were blessed and five asked Jesus into their hearts.

### **Friday Morning at the Airport**

In the airport we saw a venter hooking a rug. He had club feet and it was difficult for him to walk. Tony and I each laid our hands on his feet. We commanded healing; for his bones to return to their correct place. He said he felt fire from his head down to his feet.
