One of the things I was led to bless them with was the passion I have for Worship...mainly personal Worship. The Lord had me tell them a little about what I experience with the Father and hopefully it would help them enter into their intimate time with the Father. We can only impart what we have been given and all of us have different testimonies. I shared that as I have a sense of entering the Throne Room, I can sense the golden floor leading up to the throne where the Lion of Judah invites me to come. I can kneel at His feet and look into his strong yet gentle eyes (He is both the Lion and the Lamb). He invites me to climb up on His lap and I can just feel the soft fur as I hug His neck. I can linger there because He allows me to spend as much time with Him as I want. He tells me He's missed me and just loves on me. We had a huge area in the front of the church to pray for like 30 people at a time, but most were ending up on the floor, so we'd have to make room for others who wanted prayer. It's not an easy thing to try and explain what happens to people during impartation, so I guess I'll stop trying here... J It may sound strange to those who haven't experienced God in this way, but all I know is people were getting free.
