For our lunch today we had pork balls that we dipped in a cabbage soup broth with fresh squeezed lime juice that was just delicious.

The LFJ team and some of the Pastors met in a small Muslim dominated village this morning. We split up into teams to walk thru the village and minister to the people. We had with us some of the men and woman that have been attempting to reach out to the Muslims in these areas, but have had very little success. Today they will walk with us and together we will minister under the Anointing as Jesus did. One of the men was the former Commander of the Rebel forces in the Philippines. I was told that last year he was interviewed by Pat Robertson on TV. He received the Lord and now has given his life to reaching to these Muslim folks in the Name of Jesus.

All the homes in this village are made from bamboo shoots and it is obvious that any good rain would soak the inside of their homes. He first took us to the home of a Muslim soldier that is bedridden due to bad arthritis in his feet. His family said that he could not come down the stairs to meet us due to his sickness. I went up with one of the Pastors to the second floor bedroom of this man while all the rest of the team and family waited downstairs. After two rounds of prayer this man was up and walking, smiling and laughing. He walked down the stairs and his family was in awe of what God had done.

In one house three old grandmas gathered and asked us please to pray for them. Two had goiters and one had some kind of hard growth on her abdomen. All received a healing miracle and received Jesus as their Savior, departing from the Muslim religion. Man oh man what a sight to see these pastors praying for these folks, just such excitement!

How about this: A Muslim family that had a 2 year old that has never stood on his own strength or taken any steps. Today we prayed and the power of God came and this little boy stood and took his first steps. Amazed at what God had so quickly done for this family, they received the Lord and turned away from the Muslim religion.

A man with a damaged knee attempted to lift up his jeans to show us that knee. The jeans were the wrong size and he couldn't pull them up. Anyways, we prayed and he was miraculously healed and another ex-muslim comes to Jesus. Bingo, just like that! Oh, these pastors are real excited at how easy evangelism just got for them.

In our group that I was in there were 18 salvations and more miracle healings. All the people touched want to be part of a Bible Study and the starting of a new Christian Church in the midst

of this (previously) muslim village. (Soon to be predominantly Christian) The pastors have set that up to happen. So, in the matter of a few hours of loving on people and walking in the Anointing of The Spirit A NEW CHURCH BEGINS!!!

I learned "Al Ham De Lila" which means "Praise The Lord". That became the sound filling the air in this village today!

There was a man with a fractured thumb that was actually short because the bone had broken and slipped down making the thumb not only unusable, but shorter and also painful. During prayer the thumb popped back into place, the bones reattached and it grew back out perfectly restored. Wow, glory to Jesus. Of course, this muslim man quickly turned his life over to King Jesus!

They took us to another muslim area and we were greeted by the muslim chief that welcomed us to bring healing to the people. He said "but first, you WILL go to the home of one of our families where the father has terrible demons. OK, let's go. We went into their home (just a thatched hut open on three sides). Many of the neighbors gathered all around to see what was going to happen. Everywhere I looked there were faces and eyeballs looking at us. The husband was curled up on the bed (a piece of plywood) in the fetal position wrapped up in a blanket. They had taken him to the hospital yesterday because he was uncontrollably screaming and hysterical. They said that he had not been able to speak a word for a long time. The hospital put in an IV and he screamed and pulled the IV out and broke it. The hospital told the family there was nothing they could do, to please get him out of there. So, they took him back home. Now we arrive. Now we wanted to talk to the man so we were going to command the demons to let go of the man so he could talk in Jesus Name. We did that and the demons responded with a "yes, we will!" when we commanded no interference from them. The wife was amazed at what she had just heard. The man looked catatonic. We told him that only Jesus could set him free and that he needed to receive the Lord. Do you want that to happen? Yes he said. His wife was again amazed that her husband was answering as she has heard nothing from him. Now this entire family was muslim. The man responded that he wanted to be saved and then delivered. He responded to our leading him in prayer for salvation and then deliverance. When the family saw what happened, ALL of them from the grandkids to great grandma ALL of them received salvation in Christ! The first Christian family in this part of the muslim village. They asked for Christians to come and teach them about Christ. That was set up. We blessed the man and the family. The look of terror was gone off the man when we left and you could feel the Peace of God in this little bamboo hut. All Glory To Jesus!

Today was an outreach day to two Muslim villages. We had a group that went with us from the conference so we were able to split up into teams. The villages that we went into were in a very poor section and it was so packed with people everywhere. We were greeted at every corner by a bunch of children that most of them were only half dressed. They didn't seem to mind as they followed us up and down the streets going from house to house praying for who ever needed healing prayer. We came to this one house and I was asked to go inside and pray for this sick man. Now the houses here in this village are not like any of our homes. They are very small most of them are only one room for the whole family to live and sleep in. All of the houses were made out of bamboo and built off the ground to stay out of the mud. When I stepped into the home it felt like I was walking on a spring board. I could hear the floor creaking under my feet and I was thinking to myself is the floor going to cave in? When you moved around the walls would even sway with every movement. Needless to say I didn't move around too much. Any ways after I entered the home there was a sick man that wanted prayer. I had one of the local southern Baptist pastors with me and he was very excited to try out his new impartation of anointing that he received yesterday. So we got right to it and started asking the man how we could pray for him. He said he has had very bad back pain for months and now he doesn't even want to eat because of the pain. He looked very skinny and weak and you could see the pain on his face. After a short prayer we asked the man how was the pain and with this shocked look on his face he said the pain is almost all gone, just a small bit left. So we prayed again and this time the back pain was all gone, but it moved into his chest. We chased that spirit all the way out as it left that man's body out of his feet. Then he stood up and started to move around and bend up and down and with a smile on his face he said "I'm hungry I think I'm going to eat now." Thank you Jesus for touching this man and that Baptist pastor was stoked to the max after seeing the power of God move through his hands. As soon as we stepped out of that house there was another man seeking prayer. He had a bladder infection and was having trouble using the bathroom if you know what I mean. Again that same pastor and I put hands on him and prayed against that infection and wouldn't you know all the pain left his body instantly. As the team made our way through the villages we saw several more healings and salvations. I guess you could say we had a good day.
