Testimonies received from Pastor Emmanuel from Sierra Leone, Africa. These testimonies were received three weeks after impartation ministry of the Living For Jesus International ministry team:

TESTIMONY 1

We want to thank God for the crusade and conference that took place in Moyamba this year. After going to Liberia with the team, I went back to Moyamba for time of rest and to give thanks and praise to God for what the Lord had done through the conference and crusade.

Five pastors from the Methodist Church and the Anglican Church came to see me on March 16, 2008. They said, "The crusade in Moyamba has brought a start of REVIVAL in the churches in Moyamba. Before the crusade, there was no peace between the Pentecostals and the other Christian denominations, but the conference and crusade has UNITED us, for the winning of souls, in this part of the land for Jesus!"

Again, we want to thank God for the Living For Jesus International Ministry, for the understanding we have been given about prayer through your teaching. This is helping our ministries and ourselves grow. Our churches are now growing very fast.

TESTIMONY 2

Previous to the teams coming, there has been a cult church in Moyamba by the name of Emmanuel. Their worship involved sheep sacrifice and sometimes human sacrifice as a covenant with the satanic world. With satanic powers they have been convincing people. The pastor of this cult was one of the participants in the conference held by Living For Jesus in Moyamba. He said that his father taught him and trained him to use satanic powers to mislead people and there have been about 20 different branches doing the same thing. But, in his testimony on Sunday, March 16, 2008, he was telling the church that what he has been doing was wrong. He warned the church to be for Christ and to change the form of worship to a Pentecostal form of worship. All the members of the church were before God and came to the altar asking God for forgiveness. We are now trying to have them understand the Bible through the leading of The Spirit of God.

TESTIMONY 3

Since the team left, we have started a community crusade in Freetown and revival services in other churches concerning the healing power of Jesus. At our first community crusade, after the impartation service the team had with us, we are seeing the healing power of God. At our first crusade, a woman at the age of 50 years was having a growth in her stomach. After the message of the good news about Jesus, she said that she felt hot in her body. That was the first day of our two day crusade. When she went home she saw that blood was coming out of her. In her statement, she said that she was discouraged to come back for the second day, but she felt something was urging her to go. In the midst of the crusade, the Holy Spirit fell on her. She went into a vision and saw herself in a theater and people were doing an operation on her. After this inspiration, the joy of the Lord fell on her entire body. The next day she went for a check up and the doctors found absolutely no growth on her. We praise Jesus for this wonderful healing power!

TESTIMONY 4

This is testimony that came from another crusade that we have since the team left as a result of the impartation we have received. A man by the name of Peter was hospitalized for six months in intensive care. During our community revival service, one of the people there was moved by God and went to the hospital to get this man Peter and bring him to the crusade. The hospital was close to the crusade field. The man came with the expectation to be healed, he could not work, neither could he walk nor talk. In the midst of the message we were talking about the woman with the issue of blood. This man took this story as personal to him and the healing power of Jesus came upon him. He removed the tube that was in his mouth (from intensive care) and he came to the microphone and gave testimony of his healing. This testimony has so affected the people of this community that they have come together to have a new fellowship. We are now looking to send a Pastor to Shepherd them.

TESTIMONY 5

There is a village in Sierra Leone whose dwellers are prostitutes and street boys. Some of them have become age able men and women now. During the conference and crusade in Moyamba, the Church in Freetown brought one of the prostitute ladies from this village. In the conference, the Living for Jesus

team was speaking about the love of Jesus for sinners and that we don't have to condemn anybody but to bring them to Christ. This was a joyful statement for her, which she had never heard throughout her sinful life. When she went back to her village, she started sharing this message to the other village dwellers. Now, the condition of this place is that if you are not part of them, you dare not go there. Even our government has made this statement that "if you go there, anything that happens to you, there will be nobody to take care of you." They have been like this for more than 30 years. THERE HAS NEVER BEEN A CHURCH IN THAT COMMUNITY! Pastors and church leaders, they are afraid to go there. A week ago she came to our church and said "God has done something, we have started a fellowship meeting and we want a church in our community!" Many people say I should not go there, but I remember what happened on the street at the Mamba Point Hotel, where the Living for Jesus team was compelled to preach the love of Christ to a prostitute lady. Immediately, I thought about how Jesus has a love for this kind of people and the love of Jesus fell on me and I decided I must go. We went there and had fellowship with them. We have given them a pastor. The village has given us land so we can have a building.
