

LFJI Report Mamelodi / Modderspruit

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We ministered eight sessions at a Church in Mamelodi a suburb of Pretoria and five sessions in Modderspruit a mining community near Brits. With three members from Florida namely Tony, Gem and Gayle and Lydia who joined us from Uganda. From South Africa there was myself, Ann, Crawford, Mabuntsi, Liana and Morne and Gerhard and Anetha.

Mabuntsi and Crawford were invaluable to the success of this mission as both tirelessly gave of their time prayer support and resources to help Ann and I find willing Church congregations to host the purposes of God through 'Living for Jesus'. Gerhard graciously offered himself to be a full time member of the team rendering his car to assist in transporting some of the team to and from venues. Whenever possible Anetha, Gerhard's wife also helped pray for the sick. Liana and Morne gave up their home to accommodate the three ladies for the whole duration of the mission.

The usual healings and miracles were ever present, as is pretty much an awesome wow factor at all 'Living for Jesus International' missions. I personally witnessed God perform three healing miracles, and then several other healings after each session. Broken hearts were healed and wounds bound up as pain and sorrows were cured by the awesome love of God present during all sessions. We held a crusade in a shopping complex in Mamelodi and an outreach into the residential area of Modderspruit, our team saw two healings, two salvations and one deliverance.

What struck me about this LFJI mission when I reflect back upon other missions was with Tony, was the intense anointing and presence of God during the worship and word ministry, delivered by Tony.

An impartation of joy was received by the congregation while the pure word of truth being preached overwhelmed the people, untruths were exposed and flushed away, untruth that has held the Church in bondage and confusion for centuries, effectively preventing the manifestations of signs and wonders following those who believe. This liberation of truth caused an intense release of pure unspeakable joy, a rising up that led to a climax of ecstatic euphoria in the hearts of the people, they could no longer contain it, and a bursting forth of unspeakable delight that ensued every tearing down of a lie, as I have never seen before, this especially during the afternoon and night sessions on the last day of teaching at Modderspruit on June 8, 2016.

Something I have not seen in all the days of my thirty-five years of Church life to date. This is, without a doubt, a 'revival in the making', I kept telling myself. Some were shrieking with pleasure as Tony exposed one lie after another. Others rolled

around on the ground holding their tummies. The chains of bondage were systematically being dismantled, from their grip upon the Souls of those previously bound up.

In the midst of this Glory cloud, that was all over everyone present, another miracle on another level was unfolding in the lives of those present. A moment and move of Historic proportions. I being born and raised in Africa, together with every other South African have lived under a persistent enduring dark cloud, an underlying racial tension of fear has always presided in and among the offspring of European settlers and the indigenous black people of South Africa.

God performed a miracle of reconciliation, that erased the scourge of apartheid in our hearts towards each other, for the duration of the mission it was pure heaven. We all together, black and white, experienced a celebration of love for one another as I have never felt before.

This was none other than a phenomenal miraculous encounter with the love of God, a watershed moment in our lives arrived, a turning point, a spark that ignited a flame of love between the two major people groups of Southern Africa, for time and eternity. We embraced each other weeping tears of relief in a spirit of forgiveness. The love outpouring was like a river of love washing over us, flowing from the throne of God. South Africa will never be the same again!!!
