Gail- Thursday night

WHEW! The service tonight was amazing! God's presence abounded. The worship team flowed with the anointing of the Holy Spirit and took us right into the throne room of Heaven for what seemed like hours. It was a blast! Many, besides the team, were dancing up front and in their seats. There were a dozen or so people who flagged at one time or another, some of them from the native church for the first time. It was very cool to see the people breaking out and using the gifts God has given them. Part of the reason we are here is to bring a new dimension in worship to the church – a new freedom. The anointing was there.

Casey and I went out into the congregation and got the young lady who danced this morning after the service. She joined us up front and danced and flagged. She was beaming after the service and told me was filled with the Holy Spirit. You could see it in her countenance. It is exciting to see God filling and releasing the captives.

They are experiencing the freedom that comes from the hope we have in Jesus and are being set free from their bondage. They are open and hungry for more of Him. It is very exciting.

We didn't hear much of what Pastor Tony spoke on because we convened at the back of the church to pray for a woman who had to leave early. She was ministered to 6 years ago when the team was in Guyana. Her husband was murdered 2 years ago and she was getting a cast off her foot tomorrow. Our prayer was that doctors would find her foot completely healed and that Jesus would heal her grieving heart. We are believing Him for these things.

The little I did pick up from the message was that there is territory in heaven that is ours and we need to be taking it back from the enemy. This is done by continually being in a deliverance mode – bringing our sin before the Lord – confessing, renouncing, binding and asking the Holy Spirit to fill those places in our lives we have given to the enemy. Revival will NOT happen without this.

There were no words of knowledge tonight. Pastor Tony gave an open invitation for people to come forward for prayer. I prayed for a woman who had a generational curse for “fibers” in her stomach. She stated that they are very painful and the pain travels from her stomach around to her back and up into her shoulders. I broke the curse, prayed for her stomach, then pressed in and prayed for the pain in her back. There was evidence of the Holy Spirit working. When asked

how she was feeling, she said her stomach was still bothering her. I called in Casey and Melody and we continued to pray for healing of the “fibers.” As we prayed, it was evident that there was a Spirit of Infirmary because she developed a cramp in her leg, that moved down to her foot and into her toe. The woman writhed in pain as the Spirit manifested itself in other areas of her body. Casey suggested she take authority over it. As she did, it exited through her toe. I had never seen this before tonight, but I recognized it as something Pastor Tony had talked about yesterday. When the pain in her toe was gone, she was released and peace came over her. She was delivered from this generational curse. Amazing!

I’ll end with this. We returned from service tonight and ate. I was typing my report; our hosts were opening duffel bags of clothes we brought for the people and others were chatting. I was about ready to retire for the night, but was uncomfortably warm so I was considering taking a quick shower. It began raining and I was reminded of the soaking rains I had heard in the morning. As I lay in bed, I thought, “Boy, I’d love to be out there soaking up that rain.” So, I put on my bathing suit and invited others to join me (*I think they thought I was crazy*) and I went out on the side porch and got refreshed before retiring for the night. I slept like a baby.

My faith increased tonight. I am expectant about what God is going to do throughout the rest of the week. Let your will be done. Let your kingdom come in Guyana as it is in Heaven.
