Mission to Guyana Essequibo Coast Last Day

Pastor Norbert:

From the very first meeting I have seen so many miracles, people getting healed, deaf ears opened, every manner of sickness healed. I have never seen in all my years as a Child of God and Pastor, so many miracles. I have NEVER seen such a release in the Spirit. The Gospel of the Kingdom that was brought forth was saturated with demonstration of the Holy Ghost and Power. They were not just good meetings, but true Encounters with Our Living God! Every single night tremendous healings and miracles. So much has happened out of the response to this powerful gospel. The Crusade was successful and effective. Normally a minister would come and speak some words out of the Bible, pray corporate prayers and then leave.
